## **Dear Valued Supplier**,

Over the past three years Sasol and our supplier community have made significant strides in strengthening mutual relationships and improving our value chain effectiveness. This was partly achieved through the implementation of the **Electronic Document Interchange** (EDI) network or **Quadrem Network** as it is known.

Today, I would like to use this opportunity to firstly: recognise your contribution and willingness to support the Electronic Document Interchange (EDI) initiative and secondly: announce that Sasol will be transitioning from the **Quadrem Network (QN)** to the **Ariba Network (AN)**.

The discontinuation of the Quadrem Network, coupled with process standardisation opportunities, has resulted in Sasol and SAP Ariba transitioning from the Quadrem to the Ariba Network. This move will allow your organisation to have **a single point of entry** for all interactions with Sasol which includes: registration data updates, sourcing requests, contractual agreement approvals, requests for quotations, purchase orders, receiving, electronic invoice documents and remittance advices. This provides a **unified platform** to the benefit of both Sasol and our supplier community.

Please be advised that all Sasol QN suppliers will be transitioned to the AN over the next **12 to 18 months**. There will be no additional costs associated with the transition and training on the new system will be available to all suppliers.

For your convenience, information sessions will be held at Sasol's three main sites in Secunda, Sasolburg and Sandton. Please refer to the attached document for the details of these sessions and kindly book your seats with Hope Mokgosi at (hope.mokgosi@sasol.com) at your earliest convenience.

You will also receive regular updates throughout the transition from Sasol's QN to AN. We urge you to keep an eye out for all Sasol and SAP Ariba related information which will have an impact your organisation during the course of 2017 and beyond.
