Introducing: **Sorting of RFQ postings on the SAP Ariba Discovery dashboard**

Customer challenge

Sort filters for the supplier under all the tabs are sorted by opening date for Most Recent sort order. This sort order does not make sense under some of the tabs and their needs to be an option to exclude closed postings.



Meet that challenge with **SAP Ariba**

Provide the option to turn off Closed postings in the leads tab. In this fashion, the suppliers will not see closed postings first for responses in this tab. In addition, "Most Recent" sort order will be the most recent activity for the following tabs in the following manner:

1. For Invitations tab, the most recent is sorted by starting date
2. For the Matches tab, the most recent is sorted by starting date
3. For the Responses tab, the most recent is sorted by recently responded by supplier org date
4. For the Wins tab, the most recent is sorted by recently awarded date



Experience key benefits

Provide suppliers the option to filter on the most applicable search criteria for RFQs. This focuses a supplier on what needs to be done

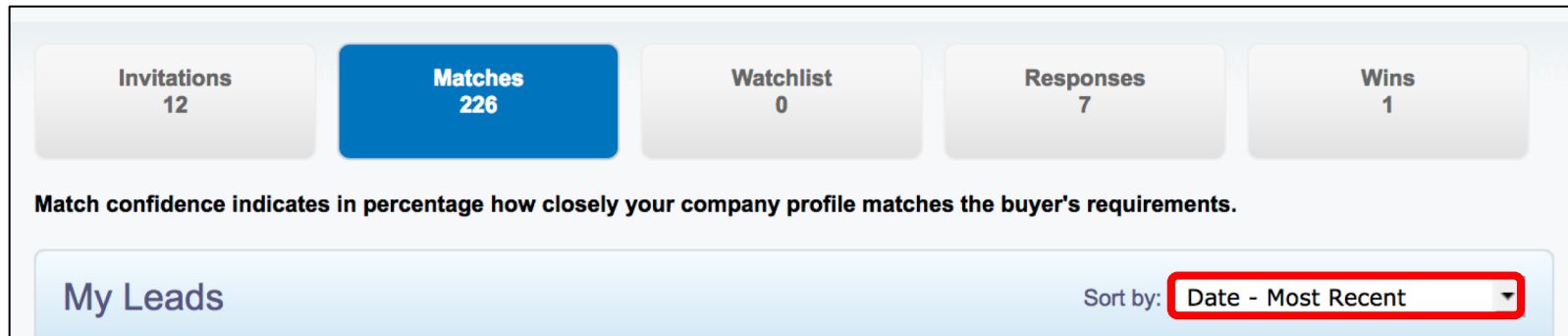

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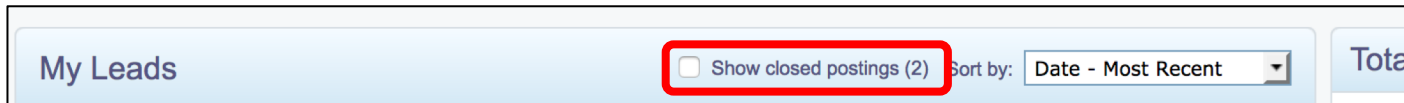

For Most Recent,
