Customer challenge

Feature at a Glance

Today there is no way to capture Tax and Segment information by Customers using Bmecat format. Customers are forced to use CIF format if they want to capture this information.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

Tax and segment information is now be supported in a catalog that is formatted using Bmecat.

Experience key benefits

Tax and segment information can now be included in a catalog that is formatted using Bmecat. This expands the supplier user base who want to include this information and whose buyers prefer catalogs in the Bmecat format.

Solution area

Ariba Catalogs, CMS

Implementation information

This feature is "on" by default for customers using the catalog capability CMS. No action is required to utilize this feature.

Prerequisites and Limitations

CMS must be enabled to utilize this capabilities

CXML Tag: TAX

Factor for sales tax applicable to this price.

Example:

<ARTICLE_PRICE price_type="net_customer">

<PRICE_AMOUNT>1.04</PRICE_AMOUNT>

<PRICE_CURRENCY>EUR</PRICE_CURRENCY>

<TAX>0.16</TAX>

<PRICE_FACTOR>0.8</PRICE_FACTOR>

<LOWER_BOUND>1</LOWER_BOUND>

Where <TAX>0.16</TAX> corresponds to 16 percent.

This field is also be supported in CIF and EXCEL.

Additional Notes:

In CIF, 'tax' will be part of 'PriceConfiguration' column.

- In Excel 'tax' will be an optional sub-column under PriceConfiguration.
- UI changes to show tax rate at Price Configuration UI both in search result page and Item details page.
- When an item is added to the cart, the tax rate will be copied to Shopping Cart Line Item and on check-out the tax will be included as part of the line item

This will be supported only in Ariba Catalogs Only. In Ariba Buying tax is supported through TLC feature. So this 'tax' value coming from the catalog will not be supported in Ariba Buying as part of this feature.

Segment

Some catalog compilers use neither classification systems nor catalog group systems but sort their range of goods into segments only. Segments are therefore similar to the upper level of classification systems or catalog group systems. *Example: Plumbing supplies, Electrical supplies*

This field will be supported only for BMEcat.
