## Feature at a Glance

### Introducing: Suppliers can cancel a failed ship notice

### **Customer challenge**

Suppliers were not able to release shipped quantities in case a ship notice failed to be delivered to the buyer's ERP.

To fix these issues, an external manual process and eventually a data fix was needed.

# Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

When ship notices are not delivered to the buyer's ERP, Ariba Network changes the routing status of the document to *Failed*,.

Suppliers can now cancel a failed ship notice, which releases the shipped quantities specified in the ship notice document.

### **Experience key benefits**

Ease of implementation

**Geographic relevance** 

Suppliers will have a mechanism to release shipped quantities in a failed ship notice document, which is the manual cancellation of the document on the Ariba Network.

In addition, if configured, Ariba Network sends a ship notice failure notification. Integrated suppliers will also receive a Status Update Request (SUR) message indicating the ASN failure.
