Detailed feature information

Guided buying forms designers can use new fields that provide user session information in form field conditions. Use them to provide users greater responsiveness and personalization in forms.

The new fields are:

- User company code
- User cost center
- User plant
- User purchase org
- User purchasing unit
- User ship-to country

These fields convey settings from the user's current or On Behalf of session. Use them in IF conditions in the **+ Add condition** section when creating conditions for fields.

For example, you could use the User plant field to create the following condition for an "Amount" field:

Hide Amount IF: User plant contains Houston

Here, the "Amount" field is hidden if the current user's plant setting is Houston.
