


Convert your Excel file into .csv file

To upload a CIF catalogue into APC/P2x you might need to manually convert the excel file into a CIF file, as this is the only supported format.

- First, convert the Excel file into .csv format : Open your template, select Save As option. On the pop up window click on **Tools** and select **Web Options**. In the Web Options window, click on the **Encoding** tab and select **Unicode (UTF-8)**. Save the file as **CSV file** then click OK.


Save the template.

Convert your .csv file into .cif file

- Once your template is a CSV file, open it with Notepad and delete all the commas and quotation marks from the header, before and after DATA/END OF DATA lines and quotation marks in the FIELDNAMES line but do not modify data lines, save it once it is done.
- Then rename the file with the extension .cif (instead of .csv): Ex. Catalogue_Vendor01.cif
