#### WHAT THE TRANSITION TO SAP ARIBA MEANS FOR YOU

We are requesting our suppliers based in Latin America to register an SAP Ariba\*\* Network account to transact with Alphabet/Google. You have two account types to choose from: standard (<u>free</u>) or enterprise (<u>fee-based</u>). When you first register with SAP Ariba, you will be defaulted to a free standard account. For more details on SAP Ariba account types and enterprise fees, please visit <u>this site</u><sup>2</sup>

#### **Option 1: Standard (Free) Account**

Beginning August 24, you will be defaulted to a free standard account with basic functionality.

You will receive instructions on how to register your standard account when you receive your first new purchase order from Alphabet/Google beginning August 24.

#### Option 2: Enterprise (Fee-Based) Account

After registering your standard account, you will have the option to <u>upgrade</u> to a <u>fee-based</u> enterprise account that offers enhanced functionality and ongoing SAP Ariba customer support.

Alphabet/Google will <u>not</u> cover fees associated with a fee-based enterprise account if you choose to upgrade.

NOTE: All parent companies and subsidiaries/affiliates for your organization that do business with Alphabet/Google entities based in North America, Europe, the Middle East, Africa, Latin America and Asia-Pacific will also transition to SAP Ariba.

#### **CHANGES TO UNDERSTAND**

#### Starting August 24, you will use SAP Ariba to...

- Receive NEW Purchase Orders (NEW POs are those created after August 24)
   Note: you will continue to send invoices to Alphabet/Google through the same channels you use today
- 2. Manage Supplier Information with Alphabet/Google such as your bank account, address, and account administrator (this is a separate process completed after go-live; more details about this will be shared with you in future message)

#### Anticipated benefits to you from these changes:

- 1. Higher degree of data accuracy from supplier account self-maintenance capabilities
- 2. Real time PO delivery for quicker fulfillment and easier payment
- 3. Real time PO status updates on your SAP Ariba supplier account dashboard
