TLS Ciphers for SAP Ariba Gateway

2305


- 1. Decommissioning of Certain TLS Ciphers for SAP Ariba Gateway in Australia Data Center [OPEC-11902]
 - Certain TLS ciphers no longer meet SAP's minimum security standards and will eventually be decommissioned across all SAP Ariba products in all data centers. The first phase of this decommissioning will begin June 2023 when these ciphers will no longer be supported during the TLS handshake process for API Gateway calls in the Australia data center.






Feature Highlights: Ability to Access the Supplier's SAP Business Network Profile in the Supplier 360° Profile [SM-34778]

 This feature introduces a link to the supplier's SAP Business Network profile in the supplier 360° profile if the supplier is public.

Benefits:

- Buyers can use the new View SAP Business Network profile link in the supplier 360° profile to access the supplier's SAP Business Network profile.
- The View SAP Business Network profile link is available only when the supplier is registered in the SAP Business Network and has an AN ID.
- The supplier's business profile opens in a new browser tab allowing buyers to work simultaneously on supplier management and the SAP Business Network.

Feature Highlights: Ability to Access the Supplier's SAP Business Network Profile in the Supplier 360° Profile [SM-34778]



Feature Highlights: Option to Require Supplier Registration Before Starting Qualification Processes [SM-35771]

 This feature adds an option for restricting the ability to create process qualifications for a supplier until the supplier has a completed registration.

Benefits:

• In the Legacy Qualification projects, the customers were not allowed to start the Qualification unless the supplier is Registered. When new Qualification based on the Process Framework was introduced, this use-case was not provided and instead customers could initiate a process qualification even though the supplier was not fully registered or even not invited. The flexibility was favorable to many customers, however, there were also some customers who requested the same parity functionality and restriction of Qualification unless their Supplier is fully Registered. So, this feature introduces a parameter that customers can Enable/ Disable and have the flexibility they need to carry out their business.

Feature Highlights: Invalidation of Preferred Status After Disqualification

[SM-35912]

This feature automatically invalidates the "preferred" status of a supplier if an existing process qualification is disqualified, expired, or becomes obsolete anywhere within the hierarchy of the related commodity, region, (and optionally) department combination.

Benefit:


- With the Legacy Qualification Projects, if the supplier was marked as Preferred, the preferred flag would automatically get removed as soon as the supplier was disqualified.
- With Process Framework-based qualification the user had to manually remove the preferred flag after the disqualification of the supplier.
- With this feature, the behavior is now consistent for Process Framework-based qualification projects and the preferred flag is automatically get removed when the supplier is no longer qualified.


Feature Highlights: Accessibility Enhancements in Supplier Management [SM-37158]

 This feature introduces the accessibility enhancements in the supplier management user interface such as keyboard navigation, screen reader functionality, and tooltips for the fields.

Benefits:

 SAP Ariba continues to enhance accessibility in supplier management with the goal of reaching adherence to the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG). The supplier management application is enhanced to provide accessibility to people with special needs.

Feature Highlights: Accessibility Enhancements in SAP Ariba Supplier Risk [ARI-15748]

 The SAP Ariba Supplier Risk user interface has accessibility enhancements including keyboard shortcuts, screen reader functionality, color contrast, and tooltips to enable people with special needs to access content and perform various tasks.

Benefits:


 SAP Ariba has enhanced the accessibility of SAP Ariba Supplier Risk with the goal of eventually reaching adherence with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG).

This feature introduces the ability to trigger a new engagement request project from a non-catalog purchase requisition initiated via guided buying, or to link the requisition to an existing engagement. This ensures that if necessary, an appropriate risk due diligence process is completed before proceeding with the purchase.


Benefits:

Transparency on supplier risk, when selecting supplier in P2P process


- A non-catalog item (1) or requisition form (2) is added to the cart.
- The engagement request policy triggers based on the supplier, commodity and other criteria (3).




- On checkout, the prompt for the engagement request shows on the relevant line items, options include:
 - Create engagement request or;
 - Link to an existing request.



- I then navigate through my engagement request based on template configuration and submit.
- The approval flow is displayed on my request summary and I can return to my requisition from the top of the page.



• When I return to my requisition, I can see that the request is in approval and can view the engagement request at any time to see the detailed progress.



Feature Highlights: Additional Translation Support for Master Data Fields in Engagement Requests [ARI-19148]

- This feature extends use of the master data translation capability introduced with ARI-18565: Enhanced Translation Support for Master Data Fields in Engagement Requests.
- Customer-imported translated values for control name, control owner, decisionmaker, risk type, and assessment name now show on additional pages or areas of the user interface.
- Benefits:
- Reduce time to value for customers utilizing the supplier risk capability

Feature Highlights: Supplier List Page Enhancements Enabled for Everyone [ARI-20543]

 Supplier List Page Enhancements is changing from a self-service optional parameter to enabled on for everyone in 2308 GA. The feature will be enabled on with no option to disable it. It will no longer be a customer configured feature using a self-service parameter

Benefits:

The supplier list page is enhanced with new filter and sort options to improve the user experience when viewing and managing large numbers of suppliers.

Feature Highlights: View Activity in Finding and Event Collaboration for Audit and Monitoring [NGSM-551]


- All activities performed for a finding are logged in FEC. These activities include the activities by all
 members of the finding's management team as well as the activities by FEC (for example, status change).
- A finding's creator and internal team members can access and view the activities logged for the finding up
 to the current time. This feature enables the finding creator and internal team members to monitor updates
 to their findings. They can also download the activity log to share for auditing.

Benefits:

Full transparency and audit trail on content changes as important input for findings reporting

Feature Highlights: View Activity in Finding and Event Collaboration for Audit and Monitoring [NGSM-551]

- You can view the activities performed for a finding to monitor its progress. When viewing the activities, you can download the activity log to share it with members of your organization and external auditors.
- Perform the following steps to view activities and download the activity log for a finding.
 - Navigate to your findings list in the Finding and Event Collaboration home page.
 - 2. Select a finding, for which you want to view activities: The finding details are displayed
 - 3. Click (View Activity): The Activity pane appears, with a list of all activities logged for that finding up to the current time.
 - 4. Optionally, click (Download) to download the activity log: A file containing the activity log, named as per the <Finding ID>.xlsx format, is downloaded to the default download folder of your local system.



Feature Highlights: Enable Collaboration with Third-Party Contacts on Findings [NGSM-3326]


- This feature enables collaboration with third-party contacts, such as members of public, NGOs, auditors, and more, in Finding and Event Collaboration.
- Finding Validators and Finding Response Coordinators assigned to a finding can add third-party contacts to the finding's management team.


Enable collaboration with third-party users

Feature Highlights: Enable Collaboration with Third-Party Contacts on Findings [NGSM-3326]


- Third-party contacts are added to a team as external team members, in addition to the supplier contacts invited for collaboration. Similar to the supplier contacts, the thirdparty contacts receive email invitations to collaborate on a finding by being added to that finding's management team.
- Finding Validators and Finding Response Coordinators can add either existing registered third-party contacts or new third-party contacts to their teams.
- They can also remove the third-party contacts added to their teams.
- Similar to the supplier contacts, the third-party contacts receive email invitation to collaborate on a specific finding, when they are added to the finding management team.
- On receiving invitation for collaboration, such third-party contacts must register themselves with SAP Cloud Identity Services - Identity Authentication, if they are not already registered. Once registered, they can access, comment on, and add attachments to a finding.






