# Introducing: **Redirect Designated Users to Target IdP after User Discovery on SAP Business Network Login**

## Feature Description

This feature makes the SSO (single sign-on) option available for authorized users when logging into SAP Business Network through the SAP Business Network login page.

## Key Benefits

All login options are available in one place; Users with SSO enabled accounts must not access a dedicated SSO URL for logging into SAP Business Network.

# Prerequisites, Restrictions, Cautions

## Prerequisites

- In order to make the SSO option in SAP Business Network login page available/visible, enablement of SSO authentication in your SAP Business Network account is prerequisite.

## Cautions

- Enablement of SSO authentication doesn't belong to the feature and requires submitting a commercial request.


