Feature Description

This feature makes the SSO (single sign-on) option available for authorized users when logging into SAP Business Network through the SAP Business Network login page.

All login options are available in one place; Users with SSO enabled accounts must not access a dedicated SSO URL for logging into SAP Business Network. Audience:

 In order to make the SSO option in SAP Business Network login page available/visible, enablement of SSO authentication in your SAP Business Network account is prerequired.
