The charts provide data visualization based on Invoice data.

- 3. Status chart displays the distribution of Invoice amount or Invoice count based on the purchase order header level status.
- 4. Time chart displays the Invoice amount and count over time.
- 5. Buyer chart displays the distribution based on the Buyer the invoice is for. Scroll down to see the full list
- 6. Source document chart displays the Invoice amount or count based on the source document of the Invoice (the transaction referenced by the invoice).
