Enterprise Contract Management (ECM) & Icertis	Question	Answer
	What is the relation between Enterprise Contract Management, the new integration with Icertis and Ariba?	The integration between S/4HANA Enterprise Contract Management and Icertis is a new integration that is offered for customers who are using Enterprise Contract Management and would like to take advantage of Contract Authoring capabilities in Icertis. There is no relationship between this new integration and the integration between Icertis and Ariba.
	Is the integration between ECM and Icertis a new feature, some sort of app or how do we access this contract authoring functionality. is it standard contract module feature?	Yes, the integration between ECM and Icertis is a new feature. The contract authoring functionality in Icertis is triggered from the Legal Transaction in ECM. An ICI Agreement is automatically created and both contract objects are kept in sync. Contract authoring is a standard feature of Icertis.
	Can we integrate only ECM with Ariba?	No, ECM is not integrated with Ariba and there is no plan to integrate ECM with Ariba.
	How is ECM Integrated with Ariba?	ECM is not integrated with Ariba.
	Does Icertis allow to edit documents without a need to download them?	Yes, there is no need to download documents to edit/redline them in Icertis.

	Does Scoutbee require separate licensing?	Yes, via SAP store.
	do we need scoutbee-licences or in ariba included?	Yes, via SAP store.
	does Scoutbee free of charge to guided sourcing users?	No, it requires an additional license.
	Is Scoutbee supplier discovery also available in classic sourcing?	No, only in guided sourcing.
	Will we need to purchase a license for ScoutBee in order to use that integration?	Yes, via SAP store.

	Can we invite suppliers only from discovery posting created via SAP business network or from within Ariba sourcing's sourcing event as well?	You have both options.
	Hello, For both discovery new features, will they be integrated from Sourcing events also?	Yes, they will.
	Is supplier Discovery a separate module with fees? does it act as Ariba discovery website ??	Based on my information, supplier discovery is part of the SAP Ariba Sourcing license. Please contact your account representative for further details.
	What is supplier Discovery module then? the one we saw in the integration part with guided sourcing earlier	(I'm not sure if the question was cut short). If no, then yes, it's the integration with guided sourcing.
<b>Guided Sourcing</b>	<b>Question</b>	<b>Answer</b>
	Is there any prediction for improvement in the fluency of Guided Sourcing? The interface, although intuitive, is still much slower compared to the traditional one, which negatively impacts the user experience.	We are working intensively on performance improvement starting from Q4 23, you will see significant improvement starting from April 2024.

	The new Browser versions will be necessary for Suppliers also? Many suppliers do not have those most updated browse versions.	Yes, suppliers also need to update their browser versions. It is mentioned in the supplier notice.
