What does this mean for you?

All RFQs, Purchase Orders, Order Confirmations, Advanced Shipping Notices, Invoices, and Credit Memos will be created and exchanged through SAP Business Network. This will enable real-time PO delivery, use of online catalogs, invoice automation, and potential new business opportunities on SAP Business Network. It also means **SAP Business Network is required in order to conduct business with GlobalFoundries.**

• When will this take effect?

In the coming weeks, you will receive important communications and instructions for joining SAP Business Network directly from SAP. This includes establishing a trading relationship via a Trading Relationship Request (TRR) with GlobalFoundries on the network and properly configuring your SAP Business Network account. We appreciate your prompt action on all communications and requests regarding this initiative (not to exceed five business days). We will begin to transition from Oracle/Jagger to SAP in July 2024. During the transition, some orders will still be created through Oracle/Jaggaer.

I already use SAP Business Network. How will this affect my account and/or other buyers?
 As mentioned above, you will receive a Trading Relationship Request (TRR) to establish a trading relationship with GlobalFoundries.

Once received, if you already have an **Enterprise account**, accept the TRR with your existing account. You will not incur fees for transactions with GlobalFoundries.

If you have a **Standard account** you need to accept the TRR with an Enterprise account. You may do this by:

- o upgrading your entire account, which will upgrade all your buyers (potential fees incurred) OR
- creating a new ANID to use with GlobalFoundries only (this will require you to log into a different SAP account to transact with GlobalFoundries)
