# Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:

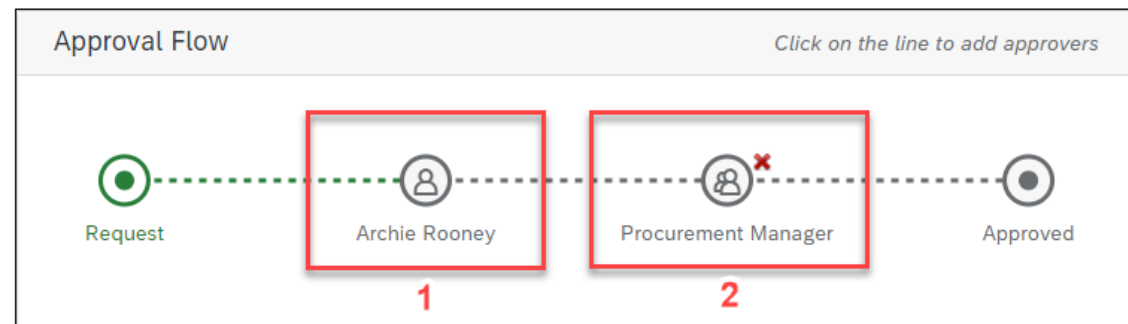


Support for adding groups to requisition approval flows in guided buying [[GB-24299](#)]

Guided Buying users can add user groups to approval flows when they create purchase requisitions

- New icons in the approval flow show whether an approver is an individual user or a group (see screenshot below)
  - 1=Individual User; 2=Group
- **Prerequisites:** Administrators define user groups in SAP Ariba Procurement solutions
- **Restrictions:** Groups can be added to purchase requisitions only, not to other document type such as forms or invoices.
- **GA date:** 2311
- **Influence Request Delivery** (over 60 votes)

## Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Faster user interface response through optimized validation [[GB-24841](#)]

**Guided Buying now speeds user interface response by validating only necessary requisition fields.**

- It validates only those fields that are used in the Expression sheet in your validation policy, and only when users open a saved requisition for editing or click **Submit** in the **Checkout** page
- **Initial GA date:** 2402
- This feature is **automatically on through** the following parameter:
  - PARAM\_ENABLE\_REQUISITION\_CONDITIONAL\_EXECUTION

## Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



### Decommission Document Approval API Version 1 [PLAF-6918]

The Document Approval API Version 1 (V1) is decommissioned as of the Q3 2024 release. Version 2 is the active version of this API. You must update your client application to use the active version.

- Version 1 of this API was **deprecated in August, 2021**, when Version 2 became available. After this date, SAP Ariba continued supporting existing client applications that called Version 1.
- If you continue to use Version 1 after it is decommissioned you may see unexpected results and your client application will stop functioning.
- **Action required:** update API Calls to the Document Approval API **Version 2**

## Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Rate limits for external approval API for sourcing and supplier management version 2 [[SS-54380](#)]

Rate limits will be enforced on the External Approval API for Sourcing and Supplier Management version 2 (v2) so that the requests made using the API do not exceed the defined limit.

- The following rate limits will apply:
  - 20 requests per second
  - 400 requests per minute
  - 12000 requests per hour
  - 40000 requests per day
- **Initial GA date:** 2405
- **Action required:**
  - Please communicate these changes to your administrators and IT teams in your organization
  - Verify that rate limits are not exceeded as per the above limitations

## Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



### Disable reply-to header field [[SS-50729](#)]

**This feature disables Reply-To fields in the email message sent by SAP Ariba**

- Some buyer and supplier mail systems and spam filters may block email messages based on the address in the Reply-To field
- This enables buyer and suppliers to receive previously blocked email sent from SAP Ariba
- **Initial GA date:** 2311
- With 2408, the Intelligent Configuration Manager (ICM) parameter Include Reply-To header in email notifications (Application.ACM.Email.EnableReplyToHeader) will no longer be available and the software will perform as if this parameter is set to No.

## Feature becoming mandatory with 2502 release:



### Custom Risk Categories [\[ARI-16780\]](#)

This feature is optional for this release. With the Q1 2025 release, SAP Ariba plans to turn it on for all customers.

Risk categories can now be expanded to include up to 25 custom risk categories. With custom risk categories the risk exposure can include data from engagement projects, customer data, and external data from third-party data providers.

- **Initial GA date:** 2408
- With 2408, When this feature is enabled, all risk categories are custom categories, and there are no longer any predefined risk categories. The previously predefined risk categories Environmental & social, Financial, Operational, and Regulatory & legal are now custom categories in site master data.

## Features becoming mandatory with a future release:



### Removal of Iframes for PunchOut Catalog Sessions [CM-10985]

This feature is optional in this release. In the future, SAP Ariba plans to turn it on for all customers. SAP Ariba will notify customers before enabling the feature for everyone.

SAP Ariba Catalog now allows punching out to supplier sites without using inline frames (iframes). The supplier sites are displayed within the same browser tab but iframes are not used.

- **Initial GA date:** 2408
- If this feature is enabled, the Close Session control at the top of the PunchOut session page for canceling the session is no longer displayed. Suppliers who want users to retain this ability can adopt one of the following methods:
- Users can click the Back button in their browser until they see the procurement application session. This method requires no additional functionality, but it might not be intuitive for users.
- Suppliers can implement the Close Session button. This method requires them to add functionality, but it's more intuitive for users.

## Features becoming mandatory with a future release:



### Copy Additional RFQ Information to Requisitions [GB-23882]

This feature is optional in this release. In the future, SAP Ariba plans to turn it on for all customers. SAP Ariba will notify customers before enabling the feature for everyone.

Guided buying can now copy more information from RFQ events to purchase requisitions, so users and suppliers have needed information for ordered items or services.

- **Initial GA date:** 2408

Guided buying copies the following additional RFQ information:

- The RFQ ID for each line item is copied to line items in the requisition.
- Supplier and touch policy justification messages from the RFQ "Accept Quotes" phase are copied to the header Comments field in the PR.
- RFQ Attachments and Comments added by either the buyer or suppliers are copied to the header or line items in the requisition.
- Service line item Start Date, End Date, and Expected Amount are copied to service line items in the requisition.
- In addition, if users click Buy again in PRs created from RFQs, GB copies these RFQ fields (except Attachments and Comments to the new PR).

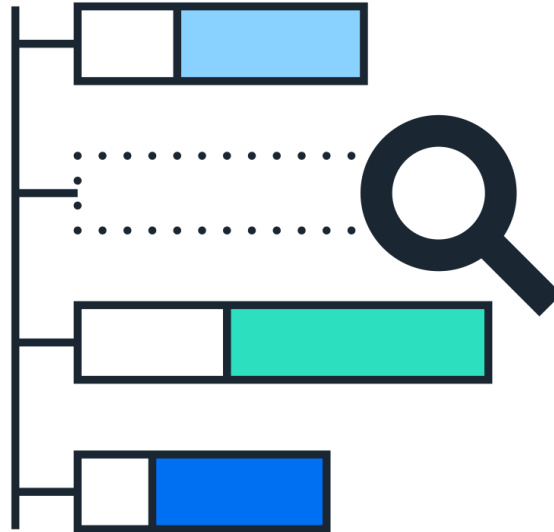

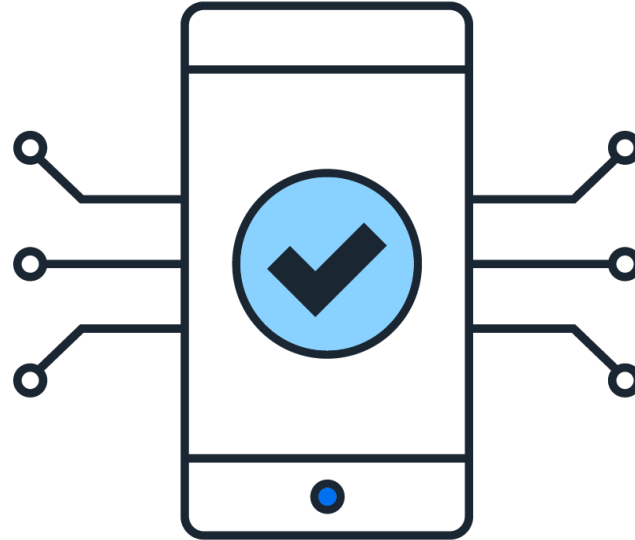

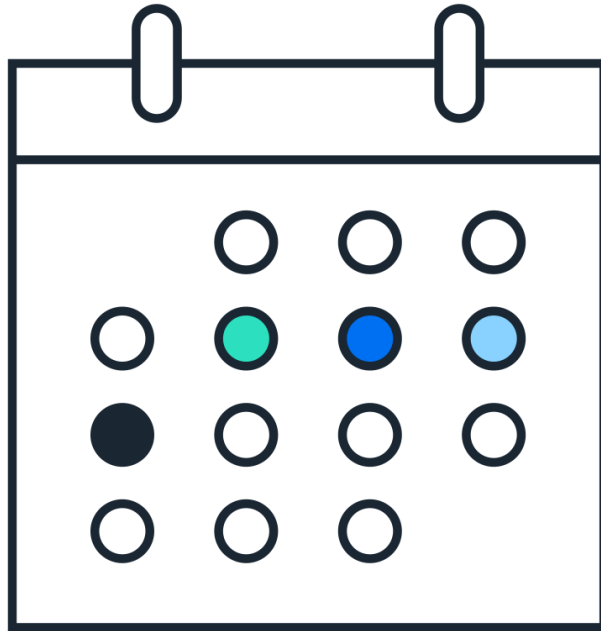

Mobile app users can now be restricted from downloading certain attachments in the SAP Ariba Procurement app. Admins need to enable the "Application.Mobile.PreventDownloadOfAttachments" option in the app's configuration.

## Manage Automatic Sign-Out for Users of SAP Ariba Procurement Mobile App BMA-6260



Buyer admins can now customize the automatic sign-out period for the mobile app. Using the "*Application.Mobile.ForceSignOutUsersInDays*" parameter, they can set the number of days for automatic sign-out between 1 and 365.

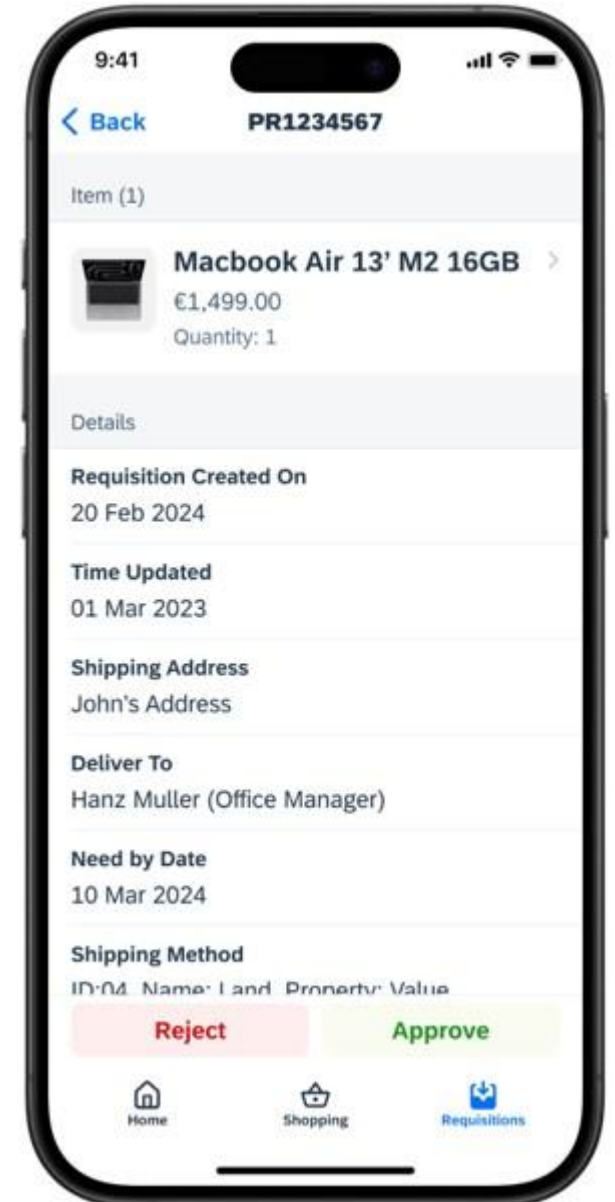

## Removal of Iframes for PunchOut Catalog Sessions [CM-10985](#)



SAP Ariba Catalog now allows punching out to supplier sites without using inline frames (iframes). The supplier sites are displayed within the same browser tab but iframes are not used.

Ensure that your administrator has enabled the Prevent using iframes for punching out (*Application.Catalog.PunchOutWithoutThirdPartyCookies*) parameter.

## Enhanced Handling of URLs in SAP Ariba Catalog [CM-11560](#)

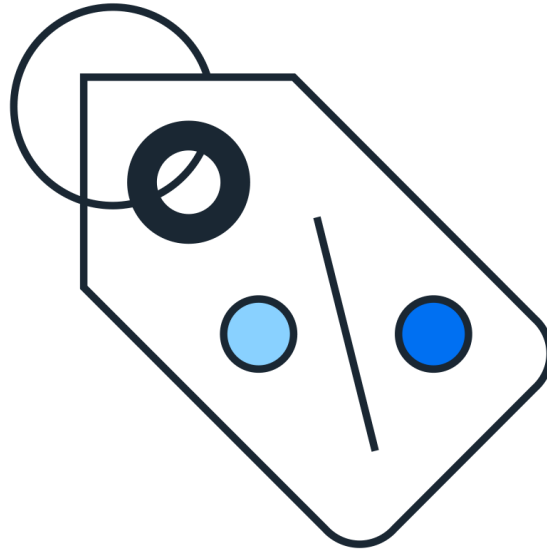


To address security vulnerabilities, parameters such as UserId, password, PunchinId, and others in the DOWNLOADJSON value for the FUNCTION parameter that are used to extract catalog data, **are now in the request body** and not in the request URL.


With this feature, data protection is improved by securing sensitive information and ensuring that the personal details are not exposed in the URL.

## Support for Updating Prices of Customer Catalog Line Items with Price Configuration in Requisitions from External Systems [CP-26879](#)



With this feature, buyers can import and submit a requisition with a customer catalog line item enabled with price configuration **that contains a price different from the mapped price in the customer catalog** without any error.

## Support to Classify Line-Item-Level Attachments to be Shared with Suppliers in the 2NV and 3EN Integration Scenarios for SAP S/4HANA and SAP S/4HANA Cloud [GB-17568](#)

This feature enables buyers to indicate in a purchase request whether a line-item-level attachment is shared with the supplier.

This information is sent to SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud.

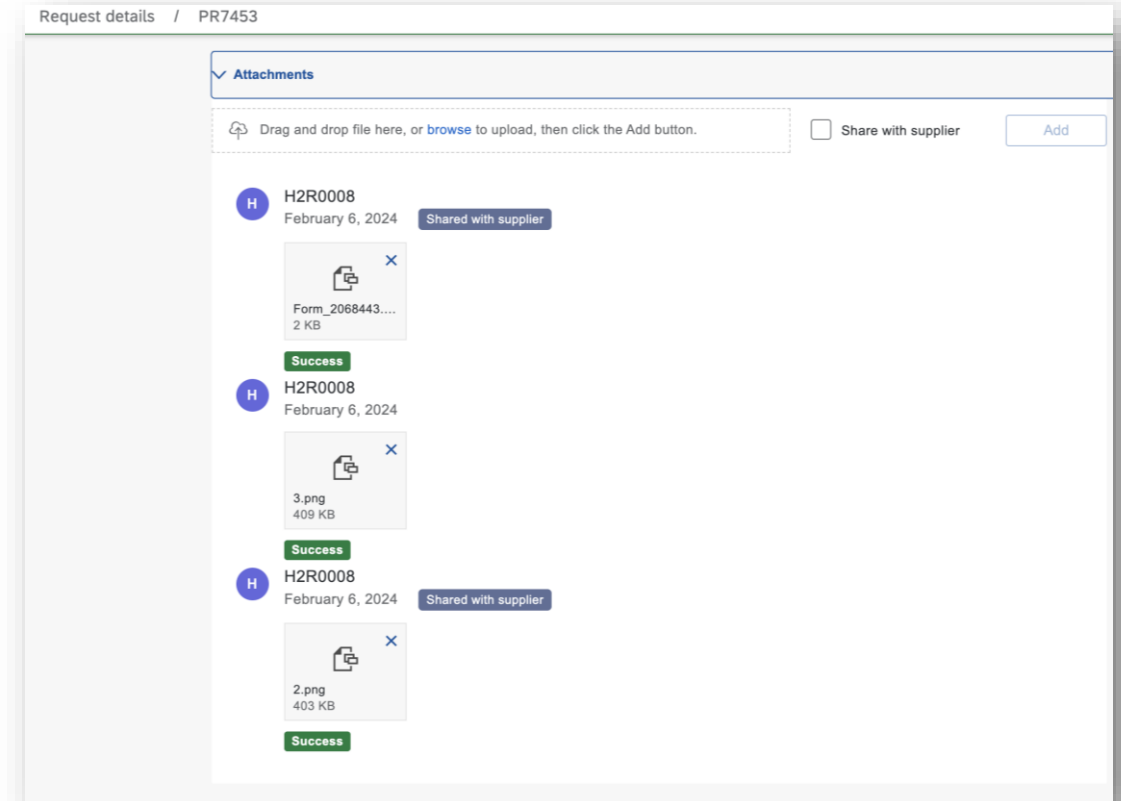
If users mark an attachment as “Share with supplier”, the attachment is classified as external and shared with suppliers as part of the purchase order.

Otherwise, the attachment is classified as internal and is not shared with suppliers.

On the request details page, the Share with supplier check box displays in the line item Attachments section.

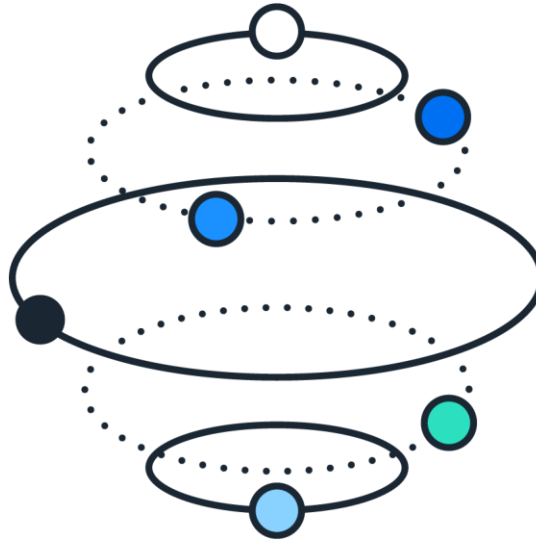
### Prerequisites:

- This feature requires the guided buying capability
- Usage of one of the two integration scenarios 2NV or 3EN
- The `PARAM_ENABLE_PR_ATTACHMENTS_FOR_S4HANA` parameter must be enabled



# 2

## Support for OData V4 APIs in the 2NV and 3EN Integration Scenarios for SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud [GB-21738](#)



This feature enables support for version 4 OData APIs in guided buying with SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud in the 2NV and 3EN integration scenarios.

- Version 4 OData APIs are used for actions on purchase requisitions, such as, creating, updating, and deleting.
- Organizations using OData V2 APIs should configure their sites to use OData V4 APIs.

### Restrictions:

- Unit of measure (UoM) mappings sent to SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud must use ISO or UN/CEFACT standards; arbitrary UoM mappings defined by your organization aren't supported.

# 3

## Copy Additional RFQ Information to Requisitions [GB-23882](#)

Guided buying copies the following additional RFQ information:

- The RFQ ID for each line item, which is copied to line items in the requisition.
- Supplier and touch policy justification messages from the RFQ "Accept Quotes" phase, which are copied to the header Comments field in the requisition.
- RFQ Attachments and Comments added by either the buyer or suppliers, which are copied to the header or line items in the requisition.
- Service line item Start Date, End Date, and Expected Amount, which are copied to service line items in the requisition.
- In addition, if users click Buy again in requisitions created from RFQs, guided buying copies these additional RFQ fields (except Attachments and Comments) from the original requisition to the new requisition.

Prerequisites:

- This feature is for only new-style single-and-multi-line RFQs, which are created from **Request form "New"** (*ProcurementForm*) tiles, not legacy Request form (*Form*) tiles.
- In addition, this feature requires the SAP Ariba Sourcing API flow, not the cXML flow.
- The following guided buying parameters need to be set to true:
  - PARAM\_ENABLE\_ENHANCED\_RFQ\_INTEGRATION
  - PARAM\_ENABLE\_EDIT\_RFQ
  - PARAM\_ENABLE\_RFQ\_REQ\_PROCESS\_IMPROVEMENTS

# 4

## More Complete Shipping Information for Requisitions with SAP S/4HANA Cloud in 2NV and 3EN Integration Scenarios [GB-26715](#)

When this feature is enabled, additional shipping information from requisitions in guided buying will be made available in SAP S/4HANA Cloud in the 2NV and 3EN integration scenarios. Previously, only basic shipping information was sent to SAP S/4HANA Cloud.

The following shipping details become available in SAP S/4HANA Cloud:

- Phone number
- Fax number
- Email address
- Street 2
- Street 3

### Restrictions

- Support in the context of Ad-hoc addresses only (not through “manage personal ship-to address”)
- Street 2 and Street 3 field values do not yet replicate to connected systems in the 3EN integration scenario.
- Street 2 and Street 3 do not display in the My Purchase Requisitions app in the 2NV and 3EN integration scenarios.
- Email address does not display in the Manage Purchase Requisitions Professional app.

# 1 Automatic detection of duplicate invoices CIM-220

When submitting a new invoice to a connected system, the system checks if the invoice already exists in the database. The system considers the **invoice as a duplicate** if all the following fields are identical to another invoice:

- Invoicing Party
- Currency
- Company Code
- Gross Invoice Amount
- Reference
- Invoice Date

In that case, automatic submission is interrupted

## **Benefits to customer:**

This enhancement helps to automatically detect errors and fraud, and increases the reliability of invoice processing automation.

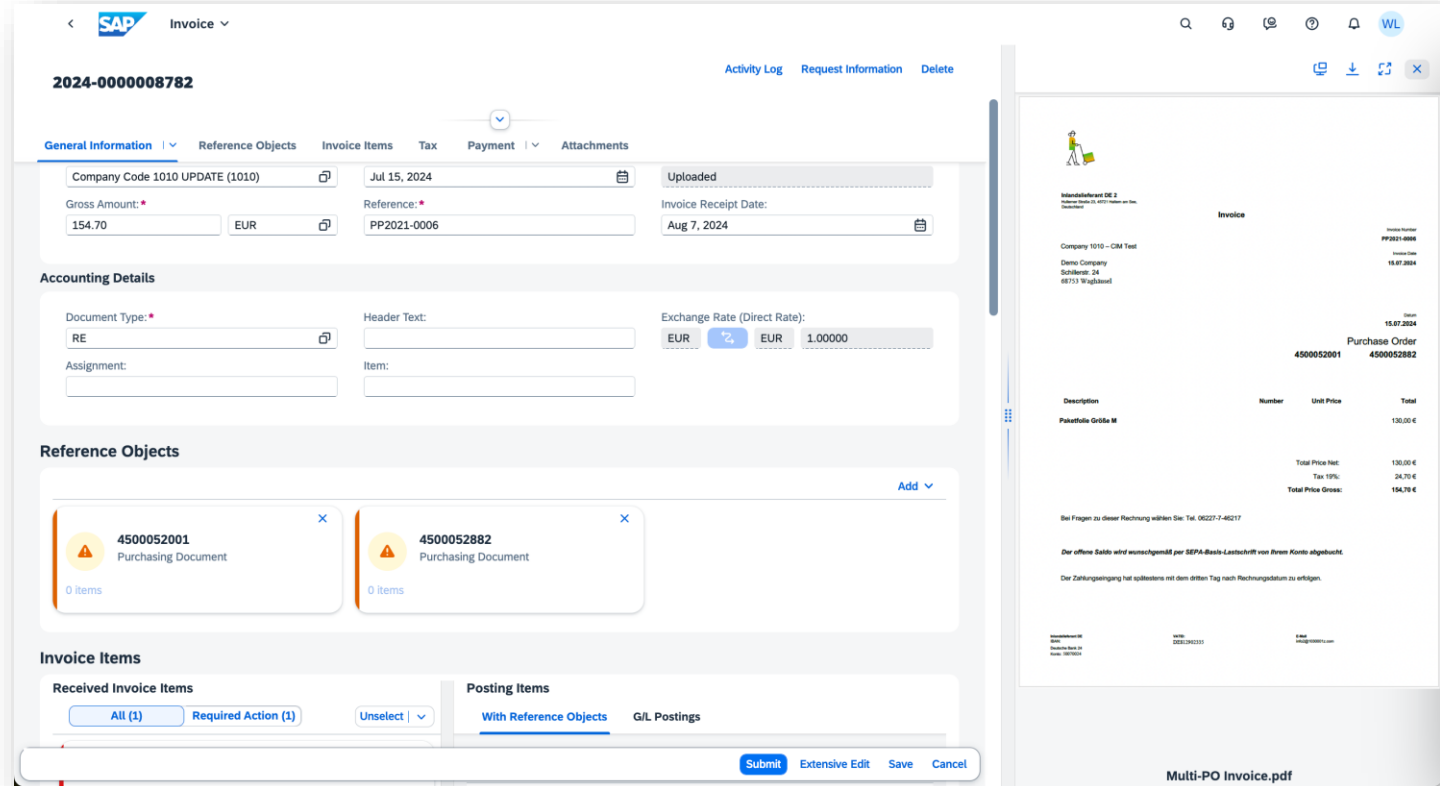

With this enhancement, **multiple PO reference** values can now be extracted at the invoice header level by using the default Documentation Information Extraction by SAP AI Business Services.

### Benefits to Customers:

This new feature allows for invoice processing automation to be increased.

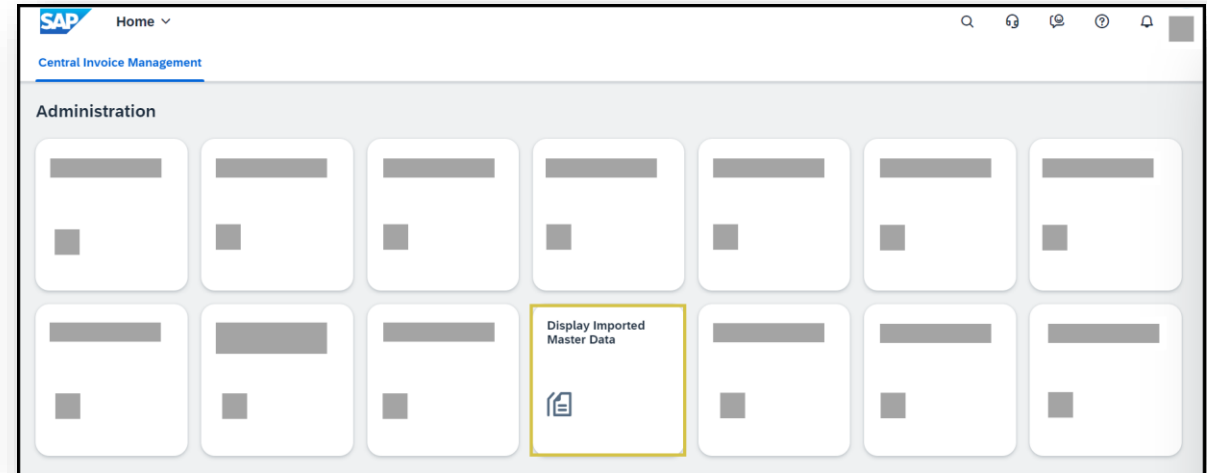

For invoice files written in Hungarian, Romanian and Turkish languages, the transaction type of the uploaded invoice is now identified as **Credit Memo**, if the following words are written on the invoice

Language	Recognized words
Hungarian	"Számlajóváírás", "Jóváíró számla" or "Jóváírás"
Romanian	"Nota de credit"
Turkish	"IADE"
