Purpose of the Guide and Introduction

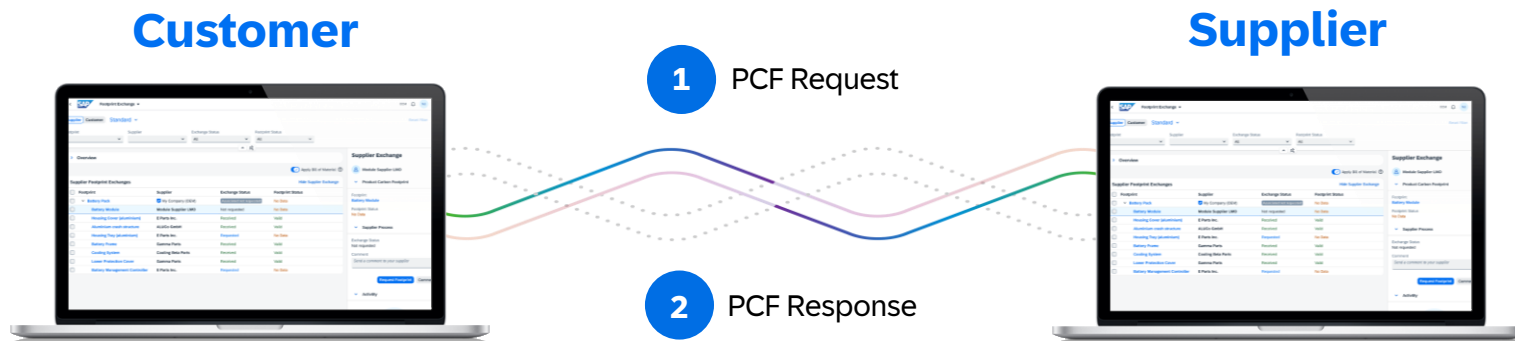
SAP Sustainability Data Exchange

What is SDX?

The application allows organizations to communicate and manage Scope 3 emissions information in the supply chain through a request and respond feature, which enables the sharing of carbon footprint data with respective trading partners. The data exchanged complies with common standards, such as the World Business Council for Sustainable Development's Partnership for Carbon Transparency (PACT), and is officially certified by a Catena-X conformity assessment body so carbon values can be delivered in a trusted, auditable way. The application is both interoperable and industry agnostic.

Business Value

This guide is for trading partners who have been invited by their customer to collaborate on SAP Sustainability Data Exchange (SDX) cloud platform to share carbon emission data. It provides step-by-step instructions on how to create an account on SDX, connect to the customer, assist with initial configuration and transactions, and explain the available support channels and documentation.

Configure your BTP Account

The set up of SDX account needs to be done in Global BTP* account by the BTP administrator.

1. Check if the SDX entitlement is available in your global BTP account
2. Create your new BPT subaccount and activate SDX entitlement
3. Subscribe to the SDX application
4. Create role collections to define permissions for end-users
5. Add users and assign them specific role collections

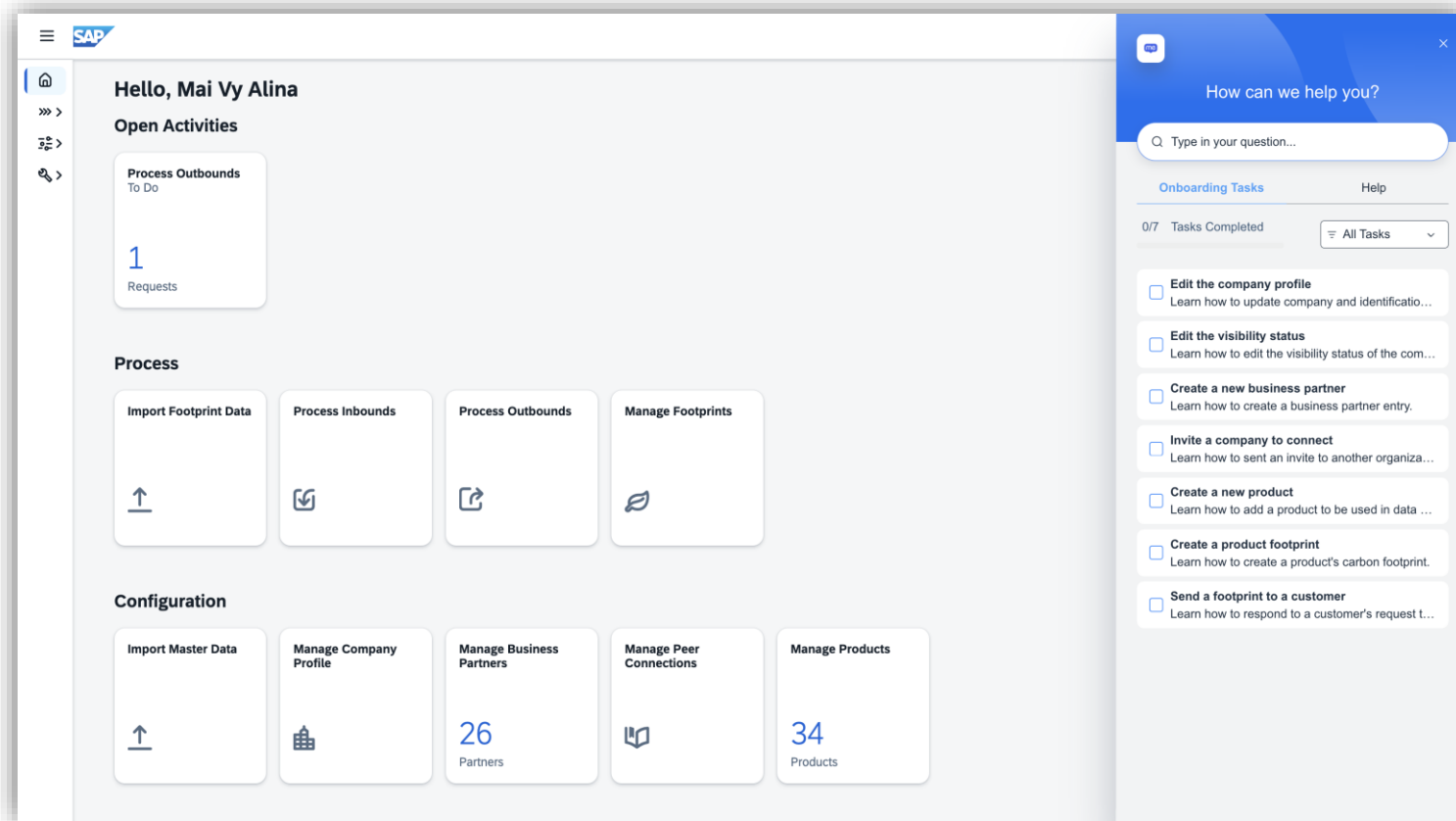

Connect With Your Customer

Sending invites

There are two options in SAP SDX available how to send invites to your customers depending whether they are publicly visible or not in Peer Connections App.

If your customer is publicly visible:

1. Open Manage Peer Connections application
2. Search and select your customer from the list
3. If you have manually created or imported your customer into SDX before, select the corresponding entry from the list of Related Business Partners.¹
4. Send Invite

If your customer does not appear in the list:

1. Ask your customer to share their Peer ID with you
2. Open Manage Peer connections application
3. Select Peer ID > Enter Peer ID of partner to invite.
4. In the window that opens, enter the peer ID of your partner and select the corresponding entry from the list of Related Business Partners if it already exists.¹
5. Send Invite

Accepting or Declining Invites

1. Open Manage Peer Connections application
2. Filter for Invites Received
3. Select your customer: Accept or Decline the invite. If you choose to accept the invite, select the corresponding entry from the list of Related Business Partners if it already exists.¹

¹ By selecting an existing entry from the list of Related Business Partners, the system will link both to avoid duplicates. If none exists yet, just proceed with sending/accepting the invite.

What's the Difference Between “S user” and “admin user”?

The Difference between “S user” and “admin user”

According to the current onboarding process, trading partners need to register in the SAP Store and place an order to receive access to the SAP Sustainability Data Exchange account. Therefore, all trading partners registered through this process will have:

1. SAP Store account
2. SAP Sustainability Data Exchange account

S user is associated with SAP store account.

- The first person in a company who placed an order in SAP Store will be assigned an S-user ID. Hence, this user is the S-user. (Check [Email C](#) for how the S-user ID looks like).
- The S user can log ticket to get support from SAP.
- The first S-user can add more S-users, allowing more people to raise tickets.

Admin user is associated with SAP Sustainability Data Exchange account.

- It's the person who can access SAP Sustainability Data Exchange account and is assigned to the admin group in the 'Users' app.
- The admin user can manage business profile, set up notifications, add/remove users, and assign/unassign groups in the SAP Sustainability Data Exchange account.
- The admin user can also add more admin users if needed, so more people can manage the tenant.
