User Story

The **Language settings** feature allows buyers and suppliers on SAP Business Network to configure key locale preferences among time zone and currency settings

Preferred Language is the language used when SAP Ariba sends you
configurable notifications. This is different from your web browser's language
setting, which controls the user interface and actions you initiate there. If you are the account administrator,
then the preferred language setting also controls the section headings and field labels on purchase orders
routed through email or fax.

In the GEN1 experience, these settings were maintained separately by role. As part of the NEXTGEN redesign, SAP Business Network has introduced a unified and standardized interface for managing these settings. Both buyers and suppliers can now view and access the Language Settings from a single location: Settings

— Language Settings. Importantly, only Admin users can modify these settings, ensuring centralized control and consistency. All other sub users can view the selected values but are restricted from making any changes

Prerequisites

- Only Admin users can view and update Org Language Settings
- All sub users can only view the Org Language Settings. Edit option will not be available for them.
- Access is restricted to ensure consistency and centralized control across the organization






Feature Details - NEXTGEN Navigation for Buyer/Supplier Side
