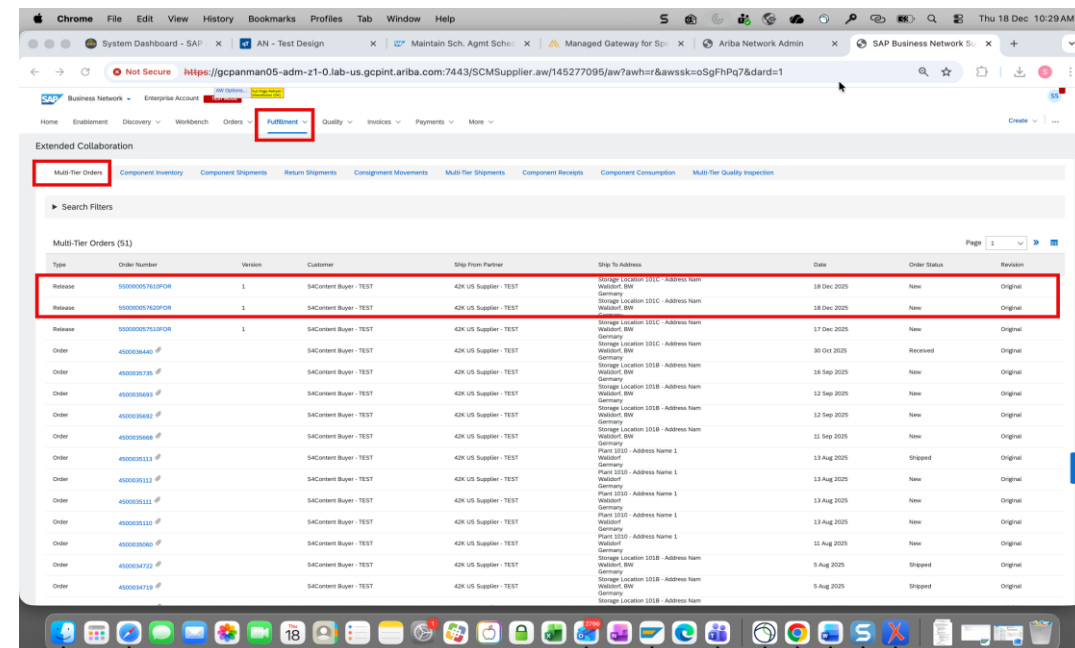
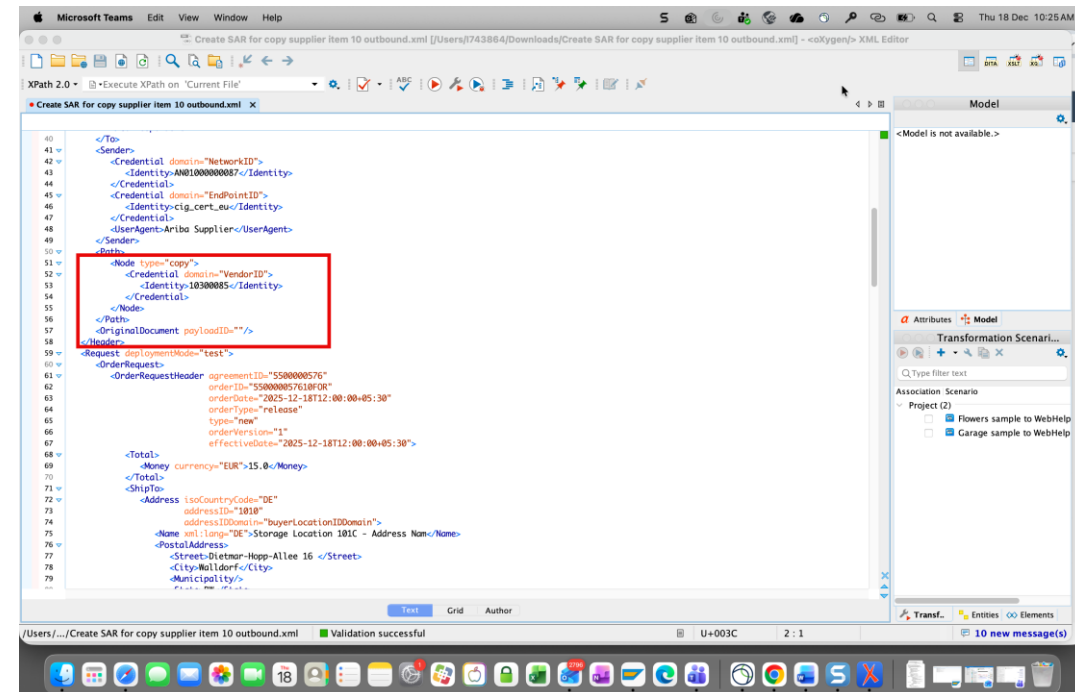
Key Benefits:

This feature automatically maps the Copy Supplier partner role (PartyType: CpySuplr) from the outbound Scheduling Agreement SOAP message to the OrderRequest cXML as a Copy node, ensuring all relevant parties in the multi-tier subcontracting process receive the scheduling agreement.
