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Feature At-a-Glance

introducing: **Editability conditions in supplier management questionnaires**

Adds a new condition type for a question in a questionnaire to allow editing of a response when the condition is met. For example allow editing only when registration status is Invited.

Customer challenge being solved

There could be certain information that is requested from suppliers in questionnaire that should not be editable after supplier has been approved for registration, like the acceptance of a Code of Conduct. Once a supplier has accepted it during registration, that assertion stands (i.e. supplier should not be allowed to subsequently un-accept the CoC). Currently there is no way to make an answer read only and prevent editing the questionnaires after Registration.

Solution to customer challenge

This feature adds an Editability Condition to the questions of a questionnaire and adds capability to make the field editable when the condition is met and un-editable when the condition is not met.

Benefits/value to customer

Provides flexibility in configuring fields for which editability should be controlled based on conditions.

Create a project level condition that when the condition is met it makes the field editable, else un-editable
