






# **Supplier Bidding by Email**

## Enabling email response via RFP template

The email bidding feature is currently *limited to single line item events* and can be turned on or off using the template rule below:

## Bidding Rules




# Supplier Bidding by Email Email invitation to suppliers

The event email notification will present the user with two options, as shown to the right.

Selected suppliers will receive the new invitation email with event header details, including following four fields:


- Bidding start date
- 2. Region
- 3. Commodity
- 4. Description

# **Supplier Bidding by Email** Email invitation to suppliers

- Respond This will generate a pre-filled text email template (see next slide).
- View This will direct the user to login to the Ariba Network Sourcing portal to view the event. For new, unregistered Suppliers, a Light Enablement flow will kick off, which takes less than 5 minutes and only requires a name and address from the user. Once their registration is complete, the user is directed to the event page.



• **Decline** - As above, this will direct the user to login to the Sourcing portal, and will take the user through the Light Enablement flow if required. If the Supplier does not wish to participate in the event, this link will allow them to communicate their response along with any comments to the Buyer.

# Supplier Bidding by Email Email response format

- Clicking Respond will generate a one-time secure email with a pre-populated body, as shown.
  - All supplier required terms will have a "\*" symbol following field label/description, otherwise, it's an optional field.
  - Attachment-type terms don't require an in-line response, and don't have a ":" following the term name. Simply attach a file to your response email; limit one attachment per item per event
  - The Quantity field will have the default value prepopulated in the email.
- Suppliers will receive a success confirmation email with the bid values received into Ariba.
- Suppliers will receive an error notification email if they send an invalid response format.

A Bid submitted by email could be rejected if the bidding rules are not followed. Suppliers will receive a failure bidding notification email with detailed information about the rejection.

# **Supplier Bidding by Email**Questions Support

- Questions are supported at both the header level and the line item level.
- Questions will be prepopulated in the email, with an asterisk ("\*") denoting the questions that are required from the Supplier. Optional questions will have no asterisk.



# **Supplier Bidding by Email**

# Buy-side

- Buyers will continue to receive event responses the same way they currently do, from both the Guided Buying and Sourcing applications.
- No change in process flow is required from Buyers for email bid responses.
- To utilize the feature, submit a service request to support so this may be turned on for your environment

- Participant read only line items\*
- Update material master items in CLID from sourcing award

## **Supplier Management**

- Editability conditions in supplier management questionnaires\*
- 2. Multiple category/region/business unit selection in supplier search
- 3. Associating descriptive answers with codes in supplier management questionnaires

## **Supplier Risk**

1. Ability to skip 'Send assessments' phase when no risk assessments are required

# **Operational Procurement highlight features**

## **Catalog Search Improvement**

- Prioritized listing of catalog search results based on relevance and utilization
- Improves access to relevant catalog data when catalogs contain large volumes of items
- Provides users with quick access to most appropriate items based on search criteria

# Open API fetching of catalog data from SAP Ariba solutions

- Enables external applications to fetch catalog related data from SAP Ariba solutions such as:
  - Catalog subscription information that has been activated after a specified date and time
  - Catalog data based on specific attributes
  - Lists of items or a filtered subset of items from a catalog

- Search and invite test account suppliers to bid on RFQs\*

- Show a list of deleted RFQs on Terminated tab\*
- 6. Sending purchase order attachments and comments in response to requests from external systems
- 7. Show closing date for each RFQ on the RFQ postings page for suppliers and buyers

- Show details of a bid award



# Framework for upload/download of manufacturing planning visibility


## UI changes:

- Renamed FILE DOWNLOADS to UPLOAD/DOWNLOAD to reflect the new upload functionality
- Introduced Uploads tab on the UPLOAD/DOWNLOAD tab




# Framework for upload/download of manufacturing planning visibility

- On clicking on "Upload CSV" a pop-up will appear (screen 1 below)
- Get the latest templates by downloading via "Download templates"
- Choose the appropriate template and enter the data and save it as .CSV (screen 2 demonstrates an example CSV)
- Provide a name for the upload, choose the type and select the file from the previous step via file browser
- Click "Upload CSV" to trigger the upload



# Framework for upload/download of manufacturing planning visibility

- On upload virus scan will be performed
- In case of virus the upload will be rejected with the illustrated error message below


