Introducing: Allow Change PO on Deleted Catalog Items or Closed Contracts

Customer challenge

Currently, changes are not allowed on a PO associated with a closed contract or inactive catalog item. There are several types of changes that may be necessary regardless of whether the catalog item is active or not - examples include reducing the quantity of the order to allow for closure, and changes of other requisition data that is not at all related to the catalog, such as accounting information.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

This feature allows customers to perform change PO actions on a deleted or updated catalog item or closed contract, based on a parameter. For contracts the behavior can additionally be controlled by a flag at the contract level.

The user is shown a warning that the catalog item or contract is no longer active. Apart from that there are no restrictions on which fields they can edit. All existing Contract validations will apply.
