

Feature information - Individual Line Item Definitions in Service Hierarchy. We have 3 levels of hierarchy in Services contd....

- Service Lines and Service Specifications and Material Master lines are all distinct in their nature of definitions.
- Today application supports separate line items definition for
 - Service Lines
 - Material lines
- For Service Lines, application was allowing a definition. But for Service Specifications application was not allowing a specific definition and using the default line definition available.
- This feature now allows the customer to have a service line definition and service specification definition so each of them can have their own attributes structure. So with this feature application allows definitions for
 - Service Line
 - Service Specification
 - Material Line
- This is applicable for Sourcing Request, Sourcing Events and Contract Workspaces

Feature information – Line Item Type Support

- In ERP service specifications lines can be of different Types Standard, Blanket, Contingent, Information and Open Quantity – to depict various business scenarios
- Also the service specifications can be made alternate to another service specification to give an opportunity
 for the buyer to ask quotes for both the line items and then decide which one to chose during the execution
 phase.
- This release will support both line item types and alternate lines definitions for ERP RFQ to Sourcing to ERP flow.
 - RFQ can now contain different line item types
 - RFQ can now contain Alternate Line Type
- A sourcing project will be created with the Quote Request with these details
- Suppliers can bid on line types and alternates
- Award can happen to a Basic Line or To a line which is Alternate to this basic or both.
- Then this information can be passed on to OA or PO to ERP
- Note: We support thiese functionalities for RFQ integration scenarios and not support these line types and alternates when a sourcing or contract is started from Ariba




