#### Introducing: Ability to clone adhoc tasks while copying sourcing or contract projects

#### **Customer challenge**

Copying a sourcing project or contract workspace only replicated the project groups and documents from the source object. Ad-hoc tasks that were not part of the template but added by the user during the project or workspace creation had to manually be created in the copied project.

#### Meet that challenge with

This feature allows users to replicate tasks in to a new sourcing project or contract workspace while copying an existing contract workspace or project respectively.



#### Introducing: Ability to clone adhoc tasks while copying sourcing or contract projects


#### **Feature information**

- Users have an option to select if phases and tasks that were not in the template need to copied in to the new project
- Task status and due date (for non recurring tasks) in the copied project will be defaulted to 'Not Started' and blank respectively
- Task properties are carried from the source project to the copied project
- Corresponding documents associated with the tasks are copied in to the new project


### Ability to clone adhoc tasks while copying sourcing or contract projects Original source project with tasks and due dates




### Ability to clone adhoc tasks while copying sourcing or contract projects Cloning tasks while copying a project


