Introducing: Configuring catalog approval workflow

Customer challenge

CMS Approval Flow feature allows line level approval of items to be assigned to different approvers. The traditional catalog approval though allows a complete document level approval only.

Customers may either want a two level approval to be in place where category specific approvers approve certain items and eventually a catalog manager approves the entire document or may just want a one level approval by category specific approvers before the content is published.

This level of flexibility is not possible and the content always goes through the two levels of approval.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

This feature allows the ability to configure a customer realm such that second-level approval of catalog subscriptions is not triggered after the associated catalog content document-level approval requests have been approved by approvers in the CMS.

If a customer desires, both levels of approval can be configured as well.

This feature allows flexibility in setting up a singlelevel or two-level approval of the content documents.




