Introducing: Configuration of component editability in the order confirmation

Customer challenge

There is no way to control whether suppliers should be able to edit components and batch information on order confirmations for subcontracting items. Some customer don't want to give their suppliers the edit capability to prevent changes on a subcontracting components/ batches.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

Based on a new default transaction rule (DTR), customers can choose whether or not to allow suppliers to edit subcontracting components and batch information as part of the order confirmation process. By default, components can't be edited.

Experience key benefits

Providing better control and more flexibility for customers to orchestrate subcontracting order collaboration process based on a business rule. Ensure process compliance by enforcing desired behavior of suppliers thereby proactively avoiding nonconformances in subcontracting process.
