Customer challenge

Previously, when guided buying converted a supplier quote into a request, it didn't record the RFQ ID or the quote line number or indicate which line items came from request forms or RFQs. However, you might need to export this information to enable quote-to-purchase-order matching in your internal business systems.

Meet that challenge with **SAP Ariba**

Now, guided buying includes this information in the requisition and purchase order data models. It identifies the RFQ ID and line number, the quote ID and line number, whether the line items comes from a request form or an RFQ, and the touch flow that was used (self-service or low touch/high touch).
