Introducing: Synchronizing incremental catalog subscriptions from Ariba Network in CMS-enabled sites

Customer challenge

In CMS enabled realms, large supplier catalogs uploaded in stages consisting of a full load and multiple incremental loads are not fully synced with the Buyer CMS service. This results in an incorrect or incomplete catalog available to the buyer.

Meet that challenge with **SAP Ariba**

For CMS enabled sites, the Ariba Network Full Subscription synchronization schedule task synchronizes all versions of a catalog (incremental or full) uploaded to the Ariba Network with the buyer CMS service.

Experience key benefits

Full and complete versions of catalogs are available to buyers in spite of such catalogs being loaded by suppliers in incremental loads via the Ariba Network.

Implementation information

This feature is “on” by default.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

CMS must be enabled as part of the catalog solution.

A site configuration option must be set for your site so that the Ariba Network Full Subscription Synchronization scheduled task picks up all the versions published on Ariba Network since the last run of the task.
