## Introducing: Upgrade to eBay API

### Customer challenge

There are updates to the existing eBay API, which necessitates changes to the eBay Marketplace functionality in Spot Buy.


- Item variants shall be displayed as separate SKU's instead of being able to filter an item by item attributes

## Feature at a Glance

### Introducing: **Upgrade to eBay API**

#### Other changes

- Ship Notices and Order confirmations were previously sent by eBay. Due to the changes associated with the new API's these documents shall now be sent by Spot Buy.
- Only the default payment card can now be used at checkout for each PayPal account that is linked to an eBay account. Previously, up to 8 payment cards could be associated with a single PayPal account. Now, each eBay account will need to be associated with only one payment card on the Spot Buy admin page. Therefore if a customer uses multiple cards, they will need to create an eBay account for each one and authorize each account in the Spot Buy admin page.
- Previously, it was necessary to renew authorization of Spot Buy on your eBay account every six months. With the new API integration, this is no longer required, as this renewal is now done automatically.
- Buying restrictions can no longer be applied to a list of eBay Top Rated Sellers. Include and exclude restriction lists for eBay Select Suppliers and Custom lists of eBay suppliers are now limited to 250 sellers.
- The “Allow Processing” toggle is not available with the new API. This toggle button was located in the Process Order Control area at Manage → Spot Buy Administration → Tools, and it allowed administrators to turn purchase order processing off while testing their Spot Buy setup.
