Feature at a Glance Introducing: Guided buying maps data of type master data

Customer challenge

Today, only primitive fields in forms can be mapped to fields in the line items of the requisition. This creates a divide in the information on a form and how that may be used on the requisition.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

Now, the solution can map any line-item data of type master data that form designers include using **Data source chooser** fields. This new capability maps complex data containing object type and lookup values and it can allow you to avoid requiring users to enter data twice.

Experience key benefits

This now prevents users from having to enter information multiple times. Also, this capability is especially useful for organizations that need to map custom complex accounting information, such as SAP WBS (Work Breakdown Structure) objects.

Implementation information

This feature is "on" by default. No action is required to utilize this feature.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

The previous limitation for mapping to only work for single value objects is still applicable, so the "Allow multiple selections" needs to be toggled off.

Feature at a Glance Introducing: Guided buying maps data of type master data

The process to map fields in the form designer doesn't change; designers will be able to add fields of type data source chooser, and specify in the Application Mapping area which field in the requisition line item it will map to.
