Dashboard Interface changes:



1. In the top right corner of the dashboard, the Company Settings and the user profile dropdowns are replaced by icons. When you click on these icons, Ariba Network displays the expanded list of menu items.
2. The Company Settings dropdown now displays a two column menu where the menu items are segregated into Account Settings and Network Settings categories. The list of menu items for the user profile menu are organised and visually enhanced using the new fonts.
3. The Help Center menu is replaced with the question mark icon.
4. The subtabs for Inbox, Outbox, and Administration will be available dropdown list. When you click any of the menu items in the dropdown lists, Ariba Network refreshes the whole page and displays the required page.
5. Account type (Standard or Enterprise) is displayed for the suppliers on the screen.

Company settings, user information and help center are displayed as icons



The user menu is now replaced with icon highlighting the initials of the user





User can now navigate between application using the drop down list. Help center on top right hand corner is now replaced with icon.






