## Introducing: Ability to copy control-based engagement risk assessment projects

### Customer challenge

Both the business details and inherent risk screening questionnaires in engagement requests can contain a large amount of detailed information about an engagement, and it can be time-consuming for requesters to provide that information. If an engagement risk assessment project is archived, you can no longer edit it or request changes, but you can copy it to start a new engagement risk assessment project with the same characteristics.

### Meet that challenge with

#### SAP Ariba

This feature introduces the ability to copy control-based engagement risk assessment projects to create new engagement requests with the same business details and inherent risk screening questionnaire answers.

### Experience key benefits

Now, to request a new engagement, the requester can copy an existing project that shares many of its characteristics instead of creating a new request and filling out the business details and inherent risk questionnaires again from scratch.

### Prerequisites and Restrictions

Copying an engagement risk assessment project creates a new engagement request based on the version of the template used by the project from which it was copied rather than from the current version of the template.

# Feature at a Glance

## Introducing: Ability to copy control-based engagement risk assessment projects

1 – Click on **Copy request** in actions menu

2 – Confirm action

3 – Edit the copied information and progress through the wizard to create a new engagement request. The copied engagement request does not include the supplier from the original project. The user who copied the request adds a supplier if necessary before submitting the copied request.
