Customers using SAP solutions expect an integrated end-to-end Source to Pay process. Automation of Source to Pay with Ariba Network is a fully integrated process with embedded intelligence, analytics, and consistent user experience. If customer is going on Cloud with S/4HANA Cloud for Operational Procurement there must be integrations between Strategic Sourcing and contracting Activities to S/4HANA Cloud.

- This integration helps customers to create a strategic contract from sourcing event or standalone contract with line items. Then negotiations can happen on prices in Ariba Network and can be integrated to S/4HANA Cloud.

- The process integration adopts standard SAP technology guidelines for a true end to end integrated experience.

#### **Feature Overview**

SAP Ariba Contracts integration with S/4HANA Cloud (4AZ) enables you to connect your SAP S/4HANA digital core with SAP Ariba Contracts for Strategic Contract Activities and Integrating that with Operational System. This provides the procurement organization the capability to negotiate and maintain prices in Ariba and keep the operations activities going with all latest information from strategic applications to operational system. This can be maintained for the lifetime of the contract with the third party.

This feature allows users to utilize the best of breed sourcing and contract management capabilities in SAP Ariba with the operational procurement capabilities in S/4HANA Cloud. SAP Ariba provides a guided experience to users to create contracts with pre-approved templates, rich clause library, supplier negotiation tools, and pricing terms management. Upon finalization, the contract can be consumed in S/4HANA Cloud for downstream operational procurement processes. The integration between the systems ensures compliance adherence to the pricing terms during the term of the contract

All data is routed through SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway (CIG).

This integration also supports using the item master data from S/4HANA Cloud.

#### **Key Process Flows Supported**

The following key process flow is enabled with the feature Purchasing Contract (Outline Agreement) integration support from SAP Ariba Contracts to SAP S/4HANA. This feature enables users to seamlessly connect SAP S/4HANA digital core with SAP Ariba Contracts.

#### Process flows

A buyer in the organization is responsible for sourcing and negotiating materials and services at lowest total cost. This includes finalizing the negotiated prices for goods to be procured and signing the legal contract with a supplier. To operationalize the contract, the pricing details can be passed over to S/4HANA Cloud as an Outline Agreement so that functional buyers can use the negotiated prices to buy goods as required.

- Buyers on SAP Ariba Contracts create contracts with document types Quantity Contract (MK) and Value Contracts (WK)
- Buyers then publish the contract and send it to SAP S/4HANA through SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway.
- When buyers update an existing contract, they can send the updates to single or multiple line items for an outline agreement.
- SAP S/4HANA Cloud buyers receives and processes the contracts containing the items from SAP Ariba Contracts to create contracts with the document category, outline agreement.
