Introducing: Adding sourcing event questions to contract workspaces

Customer challenge

Currently, questions must be tagged as contract terms in the category attribute hierarchy or in the user interface prior to the sourcing event starting.

Meet that challenge with **SAP Ariba**

Ad hoc questions that are added to a sourcing event and are not tagged as contract terms already may be added to a contract workspace as contract terms.

Provides buyer flexibility to tag questions as contract terms after creation of sourcing event.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

- Category Attribute Hierarchy functionality should be enabled
- Sourcing event questions added on a contract workspace on an ad hoc basis are displayed as read-only on the contract workspace and cannot be edited.

Detailed feature information

- A new “Sourcing Event Questions” area on the contract workspace overview page shows questions added on an ad hoc basis from the associated sourcing event.
- If feature SSR-799 (Ability to embed CLID as tables in assembled documents) is enabled for the site, sourcing event questions may be added to a contract document (main agreement or contract addendum) that is associated with a contract workspace template or contract workspace in table format.
