## Introducing: Change Request to modify a live engagement request

### Customer challenge

After an engagement request is fully approved and a supplier is being engaged, many factors could result in the need to edit a live engagement. Previously, once an engagement request was fully approved, changes were not permitted.

Users need the ability to raise change requests in those situations against completed Engagement Requests.

Users also need the system to recognize the kind of change that is being requested (significant or insignificant) and be able to set up a review & approval flow for changes that require consent before being added to the system.

### Solution area

### Meet that challenge with

#### SAP Ariba

This feature introduces the ability for authorized users to make changes to live engagement requests. A project owner or governance analyst can now modify an active engagement request. An engagement request for which final approval has already been completed is considered live. Changes to live engagement requests require a specific workflow because they are already being used to govern an actual engagement with a supplier.

### Implementation information

This feature is ready for immediate use for all customers with the applicable solutions but requires **customer enablement** steps.

### Experience key benefits

Users may now manage and track changes that occur during the lifecycle of an engagement risk project. An authorized user may now update an engagement request to address a change in the supplier relationship. For example: engage with the supplier for an additional service, a supplier is to provide a service in an additional geography, a department included has decided to work with a different supplier, or the supplier has been disqualified for a particular service.

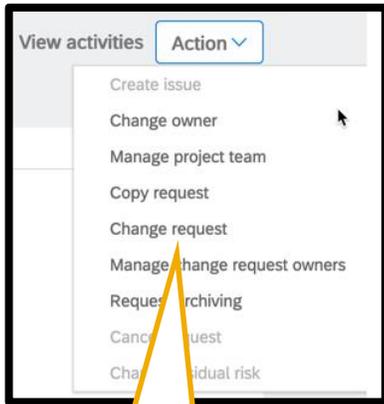
### Prerequisites and Restrictions

- Two new phases and a new team must be set up in the engagement request template
- Supplier may not be changed via change request

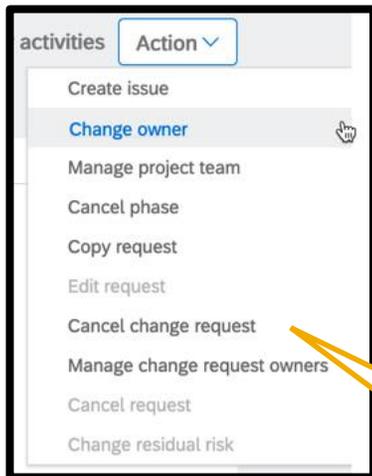

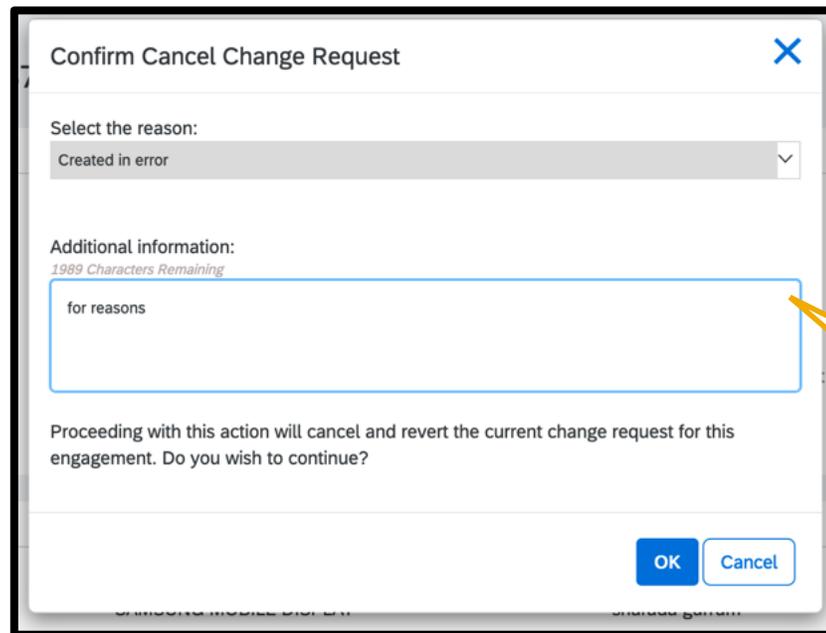
