While triggering Outline Agreements in SAP ERP either from awards in sourcing or from contracts, customization is required even though Ariba supports pricing conditions.

The pricing condition fields are treated as extrinsic fields and they need to mapped appropriately in SAP ERP.

This feature introduces an intrinsic element in the outbound cXML documents to enable seamless integration of pricing conditions in purchase orders and outline agreements with SAP ERP through SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway.


Prerequisites and Restrictions


