Introducing: Enhancements to the catalog content API

Customer challenge

The Catalog content API currently does not allow customers to extract information related to catalog subscriptions generated from item level contracts containing non-catalog items. This severely restricts the Catalog content API functionality for certain customers that have a large number of such catalog subscriptions.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

This feature enhances the Catalog content API to request and receive information related to catalog subscriptions generated from item level contracts that include non-catalog items.

Experience key benefits

Customers may now receive a more comprehensive extract of their catalogs via the catalog content API. The extract includes information about catalog subscriptions generated from item level contracts.

Catalog subscriptions generated from item level contracts that include non-catalog items are now included in the response to request for catalogs using the GET /catalogs?date={YYYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ss} endpoint.

The following catalog fields may now be specified in the select parameter when requesting for catalog items using the GET /catalogname/{{CatalogName}}/supplierid/{Domain:Value}/items endpoint:

- ApplicableContracts
- PriceConfiguration

These fields are included for all applicable items in the response.
