Introducing: Support for fetching catalog data from non-CMS-enabled sites using the Catalog Content API

Customer challenge

Currently customers with SAP Ariba solution sites NOT enabled with Content Management System (CMS) are unable to leverage the catalog content API to extract and further utilize the catalog data. It was also NOT possible for customers to extract catalog data in the same SAP Ariba solution from multiple client applications.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

With this feature, the Catalog content API allows client applications to fetch catalog data from SAP Ariba solution sites that are NOT enabled with content management system (CMS). This feature also supports enabling multiple client applications to fetch catalog data from the same SAP Ariba solution.

The user interface to enter client application's OAuth client ID has moved from Catalog Content Manager workspace to Catalog Manager workspace.

Experience key benefits

Catalog data extracted (from customer sites NOT enabled with Content Management System (CMS)) using the Catalog content API can now be leveraged by customers for any follow-on processes.
