An API does not currently exist to manage team members in SAP Ariba Sourcing and Contracts.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

The Project Management API enables buyers using SAP Ariba Sourcing and Contracts to add or delete users in a project group that is part of a sourcing project or a contract workspace.

Buyers may also retrieve lists of project groups and members of the groups from a sourcing or contract project.

The API supports the following actions:

- Get to retrieve a list of users and user groups in a project.
- Post to add users to a project group.
- Delete to delete users from a project group.

Introducing: Project Management API

The following table describes the various parameters supported in the Project Management API calls.

Parameter	Method	Description	Variables or examples
projects	GET, POST, DELETE	Specify the sourcing project ID or the contract workspace ID that you want to query for users or groups, contains the groups that you want to add user to or delete users from.	<i>projectID</i>
teams	GET, POST, DELETE	Specify the project group that you want to query for users, add users to, or delete users from.	<i>teamID</i>
realm	GET, POST, DELETE	Name of the realm or site to which the project belongs.	<i>realm-name</i>
user	GET, POST, DELETE	Name of the user that is running the API call.	<i>username</i>
passwordAdapter	GET, POST, DELETE	Password adapter for authenticating the user that is running the API call.	<i>passwordAdapterName</i>
uniquename	POST, DELETE	Name of the user that you want to add to or delete from the project group.	<i>name1</i>
passwordadapter	POST, DELETE	Password adapter for the user that you want to add to or delete from the project group.	<i>passwordAdapterN</i>
