This is to notify you that, as of May 2nd 2021, BNET will start using its new eProcurement solution SAP Ariba for its sourcing transactions. By June 10th 2021, all purchase orders, invoices and related documents will be transmitted only through Ariba Network. This will allow us to do business with you in the most efficient, compliant, and environmentally friendly way.

> Why this change?

BNET's goal is to move away from hard copy and manually transmitted documents to an electronic and more optimized process with timely and efficient payment processing for goods and services.

> What does this require from you?

On May 6nd 2021, You will receive an email from the BNET/Ariba asking you to create an Ariba Network account and complete BNET's registration questionnaire. Use the links provided in the email to set up your supplier account on the Ariba Network.

- □ If you're already on Ariba, we'll see you there!
- □ If you're new to Ariba, you will need to sign up for the **FREE Ariba Network Standard Account** to receive future purchase orders and submit invoices using the Ariba Network.

We would like to inform you that receiving PO's and submitting invoices via this interactive platform over the Ariba network is <u>free of charge</u> and you will not incur any fees unless you choose to upgrade from Ariba Standard account (Light account) to the Ariba Enterprise account (Full use account). BNET will no longer accept paper invoices for purchase orders placed after June, 10th 2021. You can flip the order into an invoice via Ariba Network. Invoices via post or email will be **rejected**.

> Useful Tips & Tricks

Here are a few helpful hints to ensure your transactions are seamless:

- Use the one-time password created during account set-up to log into the network from email links.
- Retain the email notifications received related to an active purchase orders or invoices. The links provided in these notifications are needed to continue accessing the network.
- Automatic notifications are sent to you when there is status change for an invoice or payment. You can use these links to continue accessing the network and viewing payment status.
