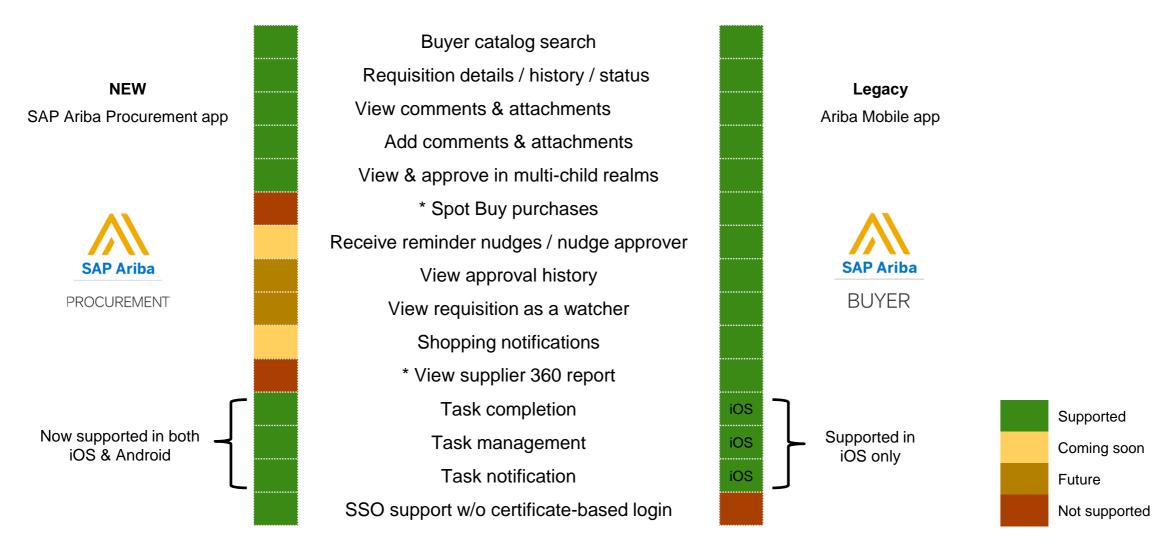

Detailed feature information – New Portal and Workbench vs. Classic View

Upon enablement of this feature in the supplier account, all users will login to the new supplier portal home page instead of the classic network home page. From there they can use the new workbench to access and process transactions, or navigate to other menu items or Ariba solutions (like Ariba Discovery).

The portal home page introduces a new shell bar, menu bar, search bar, configurable tile overview bar, getting started, configurable My widgets section with customer chooser.

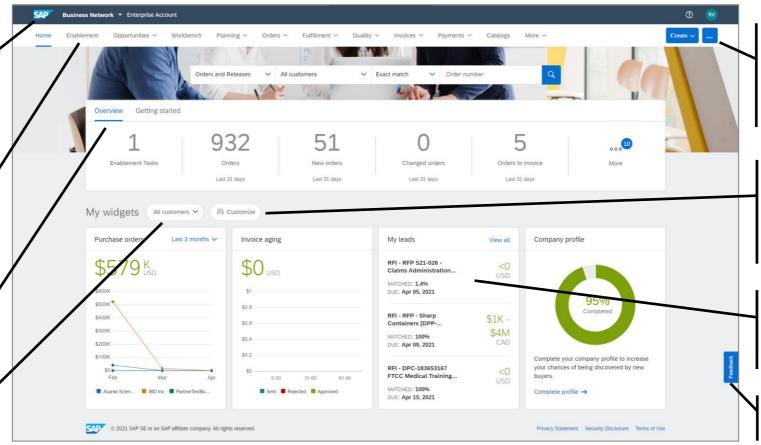

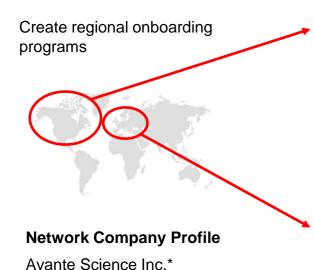

Introducing: Improved Supplier Onboarding Experience for Trading Relationship Request Invitations

Detailed feature information – Supporting Regional Onboarding Programs

With the new buyer-branded Trading Relationship Request letter template, buyers can implement regional onboarding programs instead of "one size fits all" supplier communication. Buyers can customize a "company on invitation" (which is the SoldTo party for the supplier) with logo, and a "contact on invitation" including phone number and email address for each region. Buyers can then send customized TRR invitations from the regional trading partner that the supplier normally trades with.

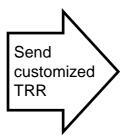

Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying

Customer challenge

Today users who need to create a Team requisition may only do so in Ariba Buying. For many users who operate exclusively in guided buying this is a disjointed experience. Navigating multiple interfaces for common requisition scenarios is not an optimal user experience and may cause confusion, increased support requests, and training challenges.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

Guided buying now allows users to collaborate when purchasing, leveraging the combined skills of individuals. Users and administrators create teams of users who work together to create requisitions and receipts for a common organizational goal.

Experience key benefits

This feature enables a user within a team to access the requisitions created by the requester, including requisitions in the Composing state.

The team member may perform any action on the requisition that the requester may execute; edit, cancel, submit, delete, or withdraw the requisition.

The approval process for receipts may be configured to include requesters and their team members to allow anyone from the requester's team to receive goods associated with team requisitions or requisitions flagged for team receiving.

Implementation information

This feature is **automatically on** for all customers with the applicable solutions and is ready for immediate use.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

Teams are defined differently in SAP Ariba Procurement solutions and guided buying. SAP Ariba Procurement solutions team requisitions aren't supported in guided buying; similarly, guided buying team requisitions aren't supported in SAP Ariba Procurement solutions.

Team receiving isn't available if the administrator sets either of the following guided buying parameters:

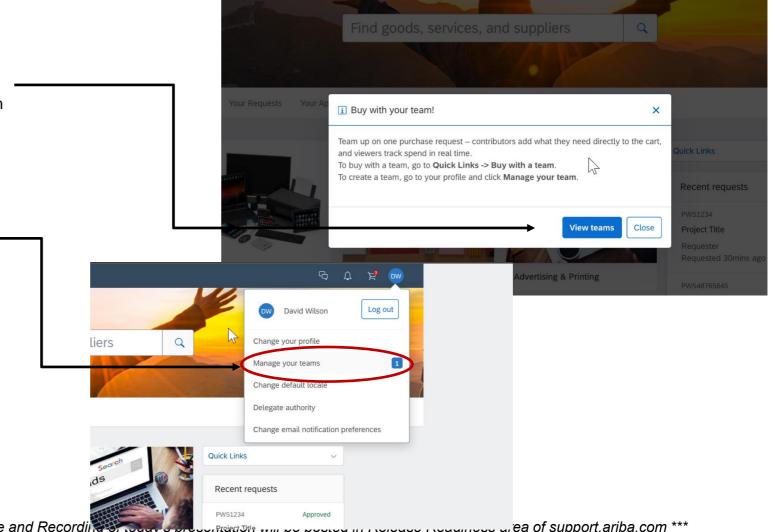
ENABLE_RECEIVING_MANAGER: Allows users (such as receiving managers) to receive on behalf of other users.

Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying – General

The first time users log in, guided buying displays a window that introduces team buying and allows them to go to the **Manage your teams** page to turn on automatic team buying and define their own teams. This window displays for each user until they click View Teams or Close to dismiss it.

The User menu in the guided buying application header has a new choice named Manage your teams, which allows users to turn on automatic team buying and see the teams to which they belong. They can set their default team, create new teams, and add other users to those teams.



Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying

A user can manually select to initiate team buying or can configure GB to automatically start team buying on every requisition.

 For manual team buying, in the guided buying home page, select Quick Links > Buy with a team.

Click the down arrow, scroll to the team you want, and click to choose it. Guided buying displays only the teams on which you're an owner or contributor. You can also select to enable team receiving.

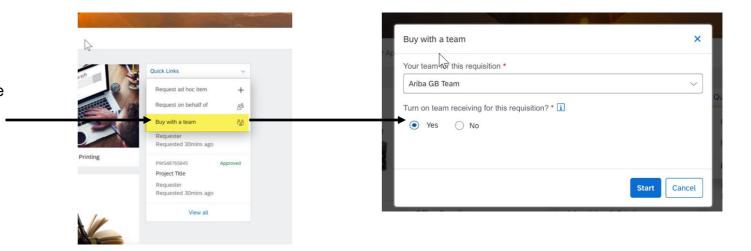
 Automatic team buying enables you to use your default team every time you log in; you won't have to select a team before purchasing.

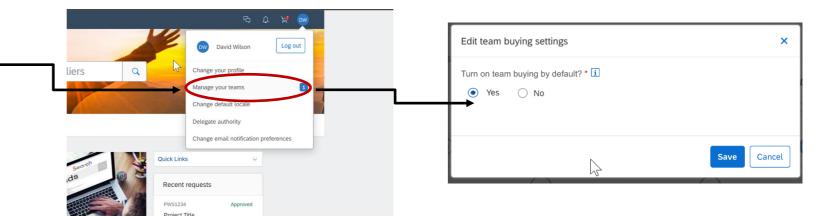
In the upper right corner of your dashboard, click your **name**.

Choose Manage your teams from the menu.

Turn on the **Automatic team buying** slider.

 Using either method, you can turn off team buying for the session by clicking **Stop** in the banner at the top of the guided buying window.





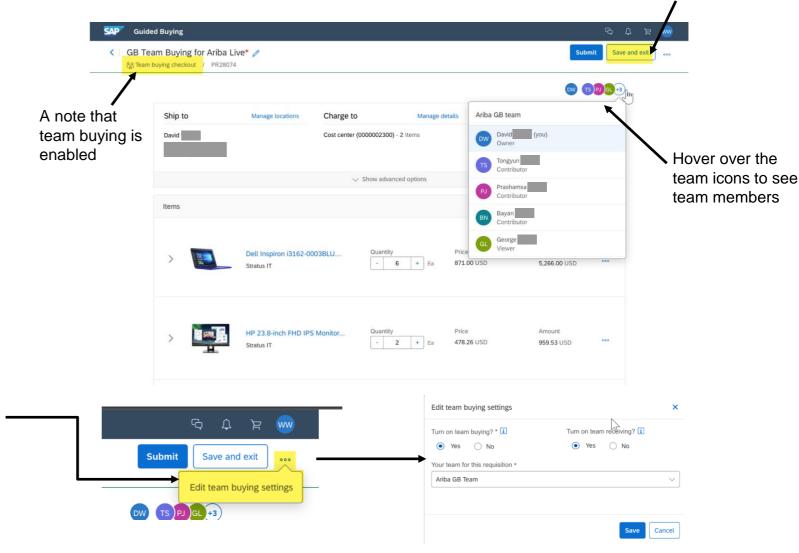
Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying

Use Save and Exit to stay in composing state

Once you've enabled team buying and/or receiving you proceed to create a requisition using your company standard process. Add catalog or non-catalog items to your cart and Checkout.

To leave the requisition in Composing state so that other team members can act on it, use the Save and Exit button instead of submitting the requisition.

Note that you can turn team buying and receiving on and off at any time while the requisition is in composing state, even if it was submitted and withdrawn.



Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying – Team Receiving

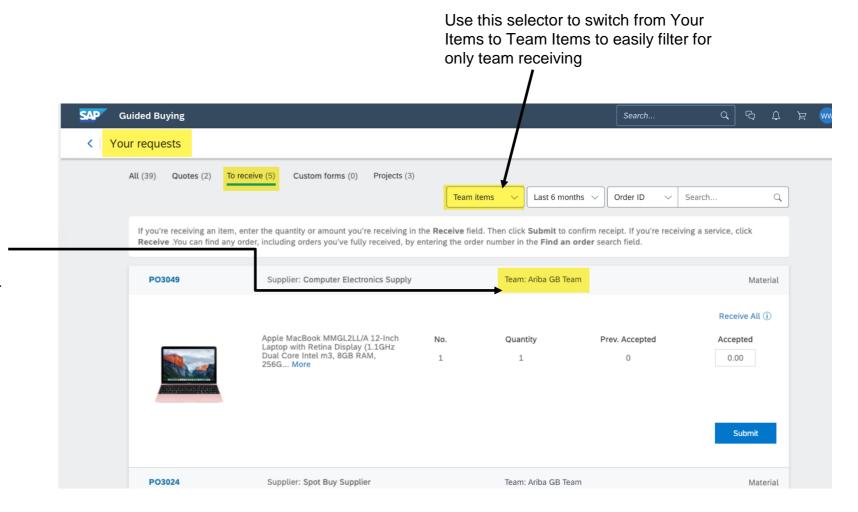
If a requisition was designated for team receiving then all associated POs will be available for team members to perform receiving.

Click **Your Requests**, then click the **To receive** tab.

Narrow the list of purchase orders displayed by filtering by **Team items**

The team name displays for each purchase order.

Follow the your organization standard receiving process.

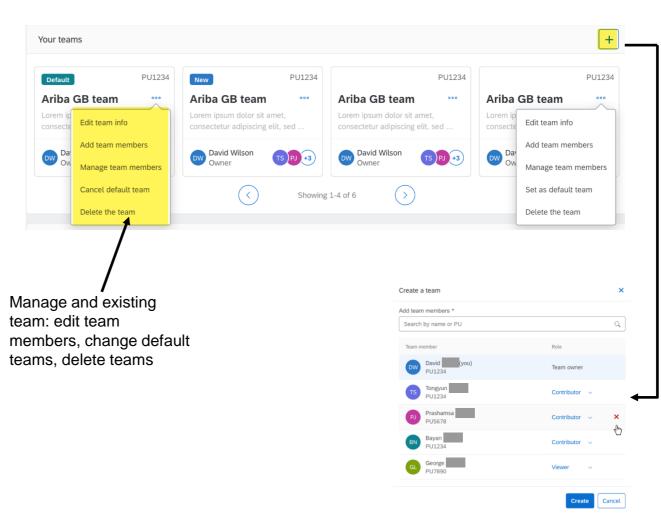


Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying

Depending on your organization's policies, you may be able to manage your own teams.

You will be able to create, edit, and leave teams by clicking your name icon and then Manage Teams.

- You can assign team members the following roles:
- Team owner (cannot be changed): Creates and manages the team. Can add and remove members to the team. There is only one team owner and this role can't be changed.
- Contributor (default): Adds and edits procurement documents and receipts for the team.
 Can also add members to the team.
- Viewer: Views the procurement activities performed by other team members. Cannot create or edit requisitions or receipts, and cannot add members to the team.



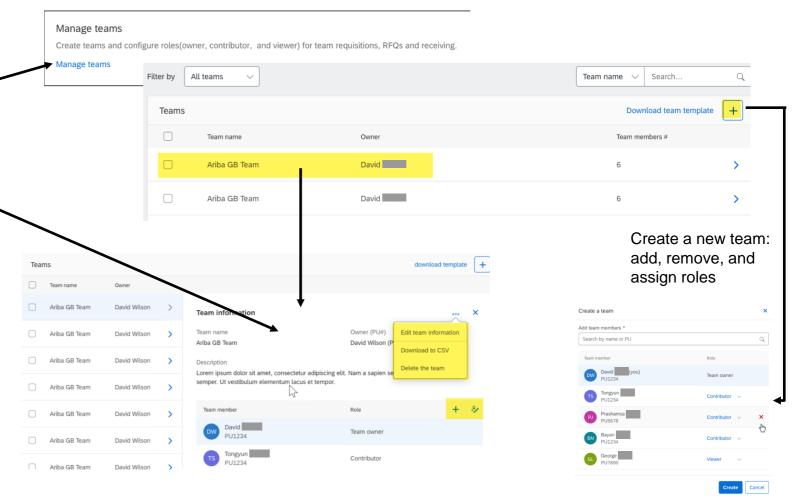
Create a new team: add, remove, and assign roles

Introducing: Team Buying and Receiving in Guided Buying

Administrators also have full team management capabilities, and can also disable user's ability to self manage teams.

Create or manage teams via the UI

- In GB Admin screen select Manage Teams
- Use the + sign to create a new team or select a team to edit. Click the > symbol to open team details and select editing options.
- Manage an existing team: edit team members, change default teams, delete teams



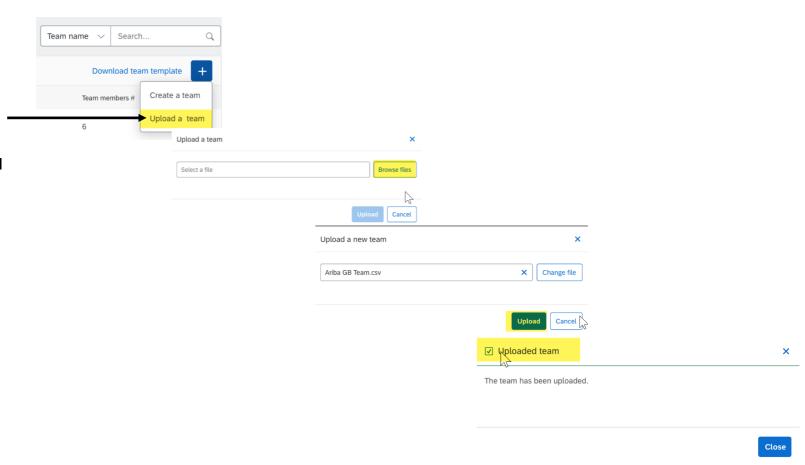

Introducing: Inventory Reservation in Guided Buying

Customer challenge

Currently buyers do not have visibility to stock on hand. Without this insight new products are being ordered via requisition or sourcing processes instead of from inventory stock; causing inventory to age out and inventory maintenance/storage cost to go up.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

Guided buying now allows users to request items from inventory stocked by your organization, such as MRO (Maintenance, Repair, and Operations) items or items manufactured internally. Users see the available quantity of each item and can choose specific storage locations when ordering.

Requests for inventory items go through the regular approval flow and can be copied and saved as favorites. However, they can't be changed or edited after ordering.

Experience key benefits

Buyers may now view catalog items currently maintained in inventory with latest stock availability. Purchasing items from stock will create an inventory reservation and facilitate follow on processes in ERP. If there is insufficient stock to complete the order, buyers can add items from suppliers as well, all within a single user experience.

This simplified process makes inventory items visible to end users and streamlines the process to reserve these stock items for use.

This feature is automatically on for all customers with the applicable solutions but requires **customer configuration**.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

Inventory items display no supplier or cost information.

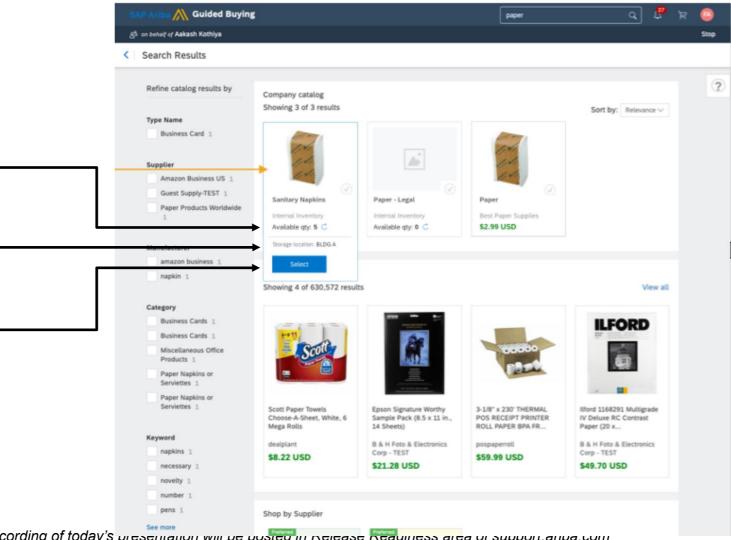
Users may cancel inventory items after ordering, but may not change or edit them.

Users may not add inventory items to a change request; if users search the catalog for items to add to a change request, guided buying does not display any inventory items.

Introducing: Inventory Reservation in Guided Buying – Search Results

When guided buying displays inventory items in the **Search** results page:

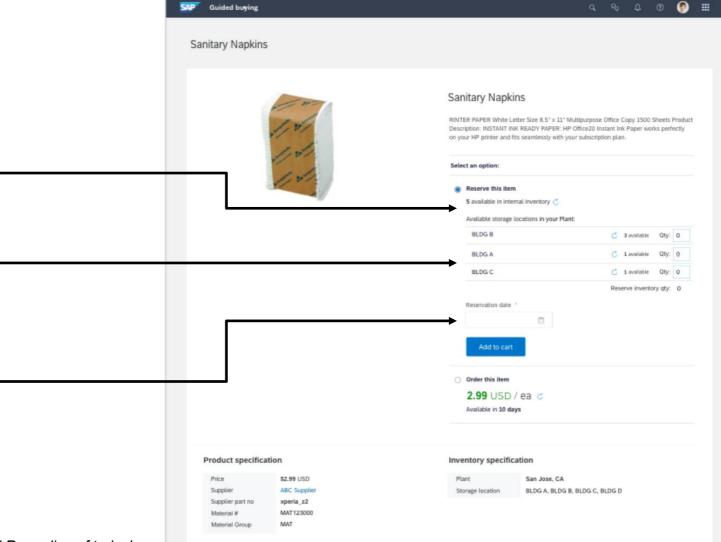
- They display the term "Inventory item."
- They display Available qty and they have a Refresh link that retrieves the latest quantity, which is useful for popular items. If there are multiple storage locations. guided buying displays the combined quantity.
- They display the **Plant** and **Storage location** (if there is more than one storage location, they display "Multiple"). Plant doesn't display if you have a plant selected in your profile or if you're buying on behalf of a plant.
- They display no supplier information.
- Instead of Add to cart button, there's a Select button, which selects the item, adds it to the cart, and reduces the quantity available to other users.
- You can refine search results by setting In stock, Plant, or Storage location.



Introducing: Inventory Reservation in Guided Buying – Item Details

When guided buying displays inventory items in the **Item details** page:

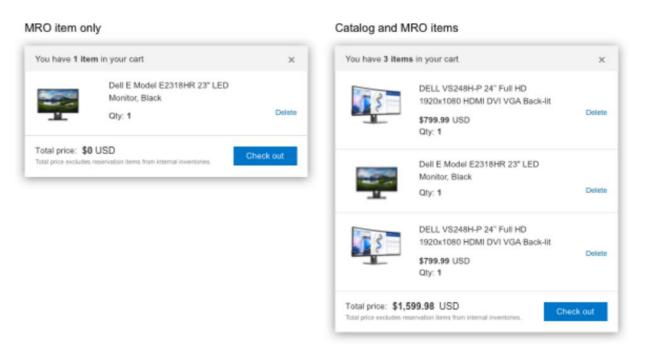
- They contain no supplier information or Lead Time.
- They display Available qty and a Refresh link.
- They display the Storage location if there's only one location. If there are multiple locations, they display Which storage location is the item coming from? which displays all storage locations, available quantities, and allows you to divide the requested quantity among each location. Each storage location you choose creates a separate line item in the request.
- They contain a control for setting the Required by Date. The date you select appears in the resulting request and it allows your inventory department to know when you need delivery of the items.
- You can click Add to cart to start a request or Add to favorites to save it to your personal favorites list.



Introducing: Inventory Reservation in Guided Buying – Shopping Cart

When guided buying displays inventory items in the **Shopping** cart page:

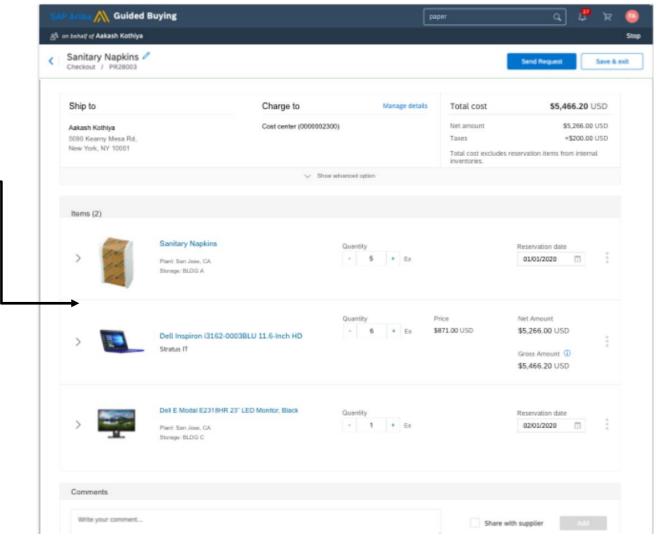
- They display the Plant (unless you selected a plant in your profile or are buying on behalf of a plant) and requested quantity. The quantity is not editable here.
- You can optionally divide the requested quantity among the available locations. Each storage location you choose creates a separate line item in the request.
- They display "Reserved items from inventory are not charged to your account." and zero cost for inventory items.



Introducing: Inventory Reservation in Guided Buying – Checkout Page

When guided buying displays inventory items in the **Checkout** page:

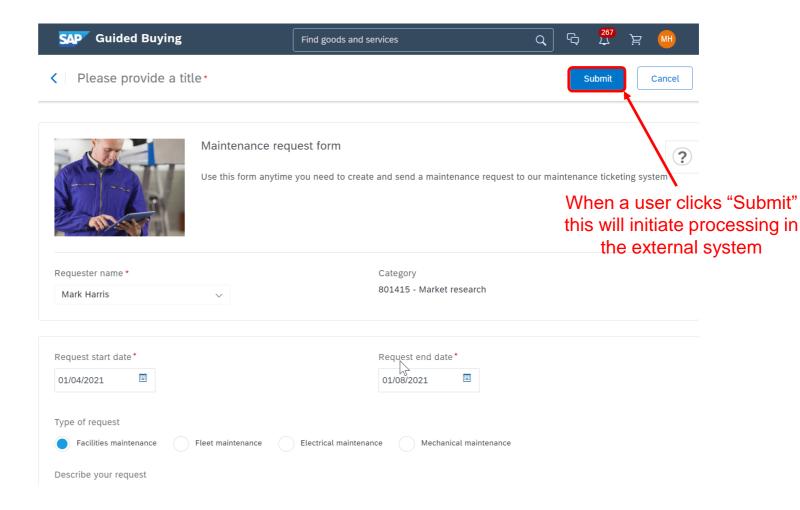
- All additional inventory item information from the previous pages display in this page.
- Requests can contain both regular items and inventory items. Regular items display before inventory items.
- Each storage location chosen creates a separate line item in the request.
- Inventory items don't have a Ship to address or a cost.



Introducing: Inventory Reservation in Guided Buying – Request Details

When guided buying displays inventory items in the **Request details** page after ordering, you cannot change or edit them, but you can cancel them.

Guided buying displays the reservation number for the inventory items that was generated by the SAP ERP.

Introducing: Editing and Approval of invoices natively in Guided Buying

Customer challenge

Previously, only simple one-line non-PO invoices could be edited and approved in guided buying. For any other type of invoice (ex. PO, multi-line, etc.) when users clicked an invoice in Guided Buying, they were redirected to SAP Ariba Buying and Invoicing to perform editing and approval. This created confusion for the end users, who had to switch between different user interfaces.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

Now, Guided Buying offers a simplified, one-stopshop, more efficient invoicing experience for most types of invoices by eliminating the need to navigate between two separate solutions. You can now edit and approve non-PO and PO-based invoices natively in Guided Buying without being redirected to SAP Ariba Buying and Invoicing. Invoices continue to be reconciled in SAP Ariba Buying and Invoicing after they're approved.

Experience key benefits

End users and requesters can now manage their non-PO and PO invoices natively in Guided Buying. By empowering requesters to edit and approve invoices, customers can achieve higher levels of efficiency and better use of AP resources.

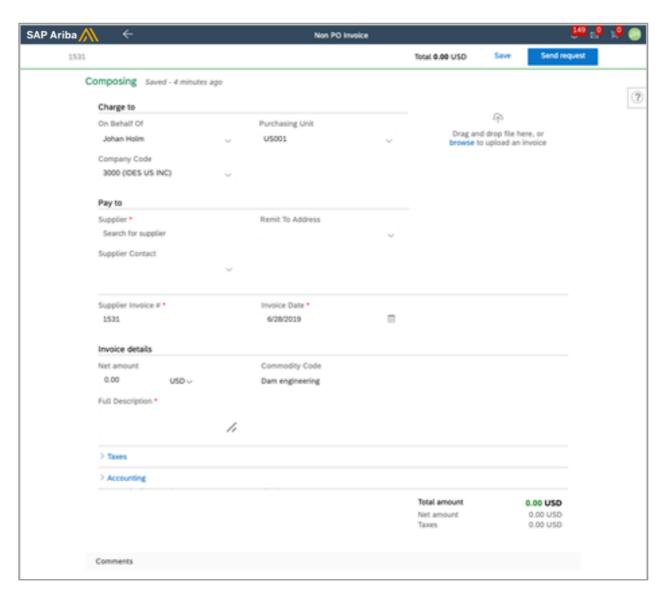

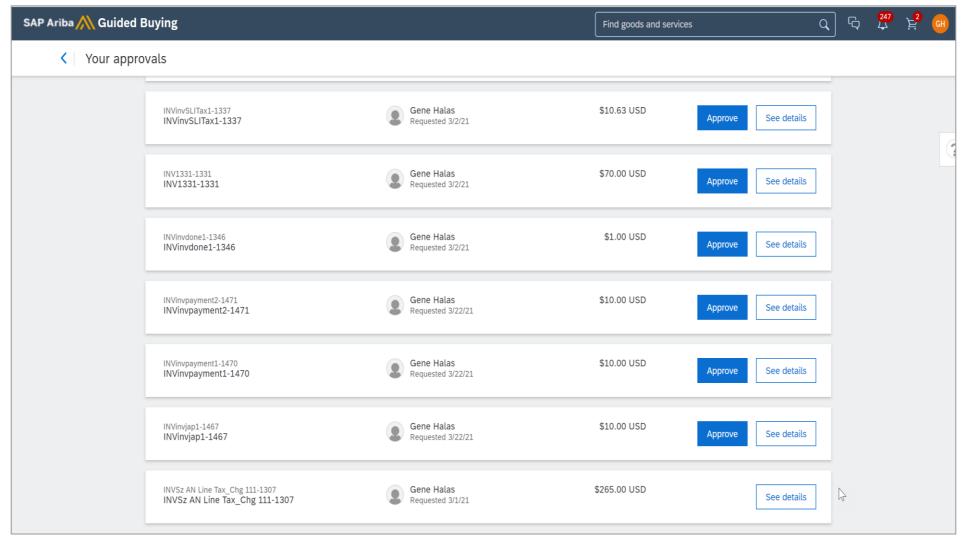
Guided Invoicing Evolving the user experience

- With Guided Invoicing, the new screens on the Guided Buying platform provide the casual user, who has to edit and approve invoices, an intuitive, simplified user experience.
- Invoicing users can now leverage the Guided Buying capability offerings, such as seamless navigation, error display palette and policy engine support.
- Support Edit and Approval of both PO and Non-PO Invoices.
- Ability for the customer to configure the size of Invoices (No. of lines) that are displayed in Guided Buying.
- Back-end integration ensures invoices are searchable both across B&I and Guided Invoicing screens and reportable in the core engine of SAP Ariba Buying and Invoicing.



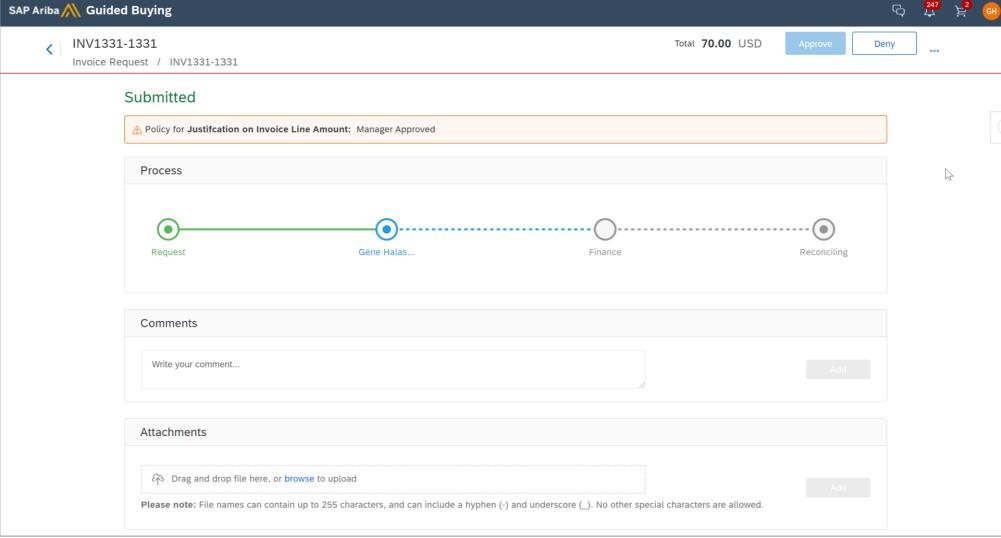

Introducing: Support for manual selection of contract when adding a non-catalog service item

Customer challenge

When creating an unplanned service order, sometime a customer might have a need to add an ad-hoc item and still referencing it to a contract with the suppliers. Today, this is not possible as only catalog items can be selected when creating an order against a contract. This stops customers from having the right flexibility when unplanned needs arise.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

This feature allows a user to reference a contract for an ad-hoc (non-catalog) item marked as Service.

Subsequent Service Entry Sheets can be created against the referenced contract.

Experience key benefits

This feature provides greater flexibility in the way buyers can create Service requisitions/orders.
