We are pleased to announce a new initiative to streamline our procurement and accounts payable processes. Corteva Agriscience is partnering with SAP Ariba® to fulfill our vision of moving away from paper and manually transmitted documents.

You have been identified as a supplier that supports both our Crop Protection and Seed business platforms. Be advised -- Our Crop Protection business platform will go-live on the Ariba Network on August 1, 2021. Our Seed business platform will go-live on the Ariba Network in July 2022.

What does this mean for you? It means you will transact (Purchase Order and Invoice) with Corteva in two different ways, starting on August 1, 2021. Starting August 1, 2021:

- When you are supporting Corteva's Crop Protection business platform, you will begin transacting on the Ariba Network with a Standard account. For questions about the Ariba Network, please visit our Ariba Portal, here: https://support.ariba.com/Corteva.
- When you are supporting Corteva's Seed business platform, please continue to transact with Corteva and its affiliates in the same manner as you are today, even after August 1, 2021. There will be no changes in purchase orders and invoicing until we go-live on the Ariba Network in July 2022. What do I need to do for the Crop Protection business platform?

You need to create a new Ariba account or use a pre-existing Ariba account to transact with Corteva at go-live on August 1, 2021.

What kind of account should I have?

When will this take effect?

Go-Live for Corteva's Crop Protection business platform is targeted for August 1, 2021.

What is the next step?
