We are pleased to announce a new initiative to streamline our procurement and accounts payable processes. Corteva Agriscience is partnering with SAP Ariba[®] to fulfill our vision of moving away from paper and manually transmitted documents.

Our Crop Protection business platform will go-live on the Ariba Network on August 1, 2021. Our Seed business platform will go-live on the Ariba Network in July 2022.

You have been identified as a supplier that exclusively supports Corteva Agriscience's Crop Protection business platform. This means that **your purchase orders (POs) and invoices will be transmitted using this platform starting on August 1, 2021.**

What will change for me?

You will receive your Corteva POs through an interactive email after go-live and will be able to log into your account to process them.

What do I need to do?

You need to create a new Ariba account or use a pre-existing Ariba account to transact with Corteva.

What kind of account should I have?

When will this take effect?

Go-live for Corteva's Crop Protection business platform is targeted for August 1, 2021.
