Introducing: Support for User Profile in Document Approval API

Customer challenge

Today customers can only approve user profile changes via the UI in the SAP Ariba Buyer application. The Document Approval API did not support user profile change approvals, thus limiting the functionality.

This feature adds user profiles to the list of approvable document types supported by the Document Approval API.

- Add the value `ariba.common.core.UserProfile` to track user profiles
- To track multiple document types, add all desired values.

Restrictions: In order to create an application and request access to use the SAP Ariba APIs relevant to this feature, you must have access to the SAP Ariba developer portal.

Customer challenge

Currently customer users accounts only require username and password for login, leaving them more susceptible to security breach.

Meet that challenge with SAP Ariba

We've implemented multi-factor authentication (MFA) when authenticating via single sign-on (SSO) from SAP ID Service to the SAP Ariba developer portal.

With the implementation of MFA, authentication to the developer portal is performed exclusively via SSO, eliminating the ability to enter username/password credentials.

SAP Ariba customer organization admin users seeking to add, edit, and delete users do so via the user management link available on the portal.

Experience key benefits

Users logging into the Developer Portal must now use two factor authentication, creating an additional layer of security, reducing the risk of unauthorized access.

End users will need to configure time-based, one-time passwords (TOTP) via accounts.sap.com.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

To authenticate users to the SAP Ariba developer portal using MFA via SSO, the organization and its users must be SSO-enabled. The first time you try to log in using SSO, you will be asked to enable your organization and users for SSO authentication



Overview

The login method of user name and password is being replaced by single sign on (SSO).

- Only SSO will be supported going forward, with no option to enter a user ID and password.
- Outside the US Data Center, there will only be an option for SAP ID Service SSO.
- Multi-factor authentication was released for Ariba Network in the Feb 2021 release. Please refer to that [Feature at a Glance](#) document for details.





Two Factor Authentication Setup

Setup of Two-Factor Authentication must be enabled to proceed.

- In order to enable, the SAP Authenticator application is required.
- Links to the app on [Apple Store](#) and [Google Play](#) are shown on the page.
- Launch the app and scan the QR code (1).
- Then enter the passcode shown in the app and click continue (2).
- The user will be directed back to the developer portal and logged in.

Two-Factor Authentication

The SAP Developer Portal - QA Cobalt application requires a time-based one-time passcode as a second factor for authentication. You need to activate a mobile device to generate passcodes. No devices are currently activated.

✔ SAP Authenticator is required in order to enable two-factor authentication.








SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway – High Level Architecture





Customer Challenge

- This feature supports Pan-European Public Procurement On-Line (Peppol) service integration for invoices and StatusUpdateRequest using SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway. The Peppol integration is currently supported only for Germany and Belgium. Peppol is a project initiated by the European Commission to develop an EU wide eProcurement technology standard.

Solution

- Behind the scene (CIG backend) and does not require a project
- Receive BIS 3.0 UBL Invoices from PeppolAccess Points
- CIG Translate from BIS 3.0 UBL to cXML InvoiceDetailRequest
- Send cXML INV to Ariba Network + include BIS 3.0 UBL as an attachment when sending to AN
- For every message receive from PeppolAccess Point, CIG will send synchronous response back


Key Benefits

- All organizations using Peppol, where the customer is the buyer, consignee, or contracting authority and the supplier is the legal person or organization who provides a product or service, can use CIG to translate Peppol UBL BIS 3.0 to SAP Ariba Standard cXML XML.

Customer Challenge

- The requirement in the German public market is to support XRechnung (XInvoice), the German subset of the EU standard used.
- Currently, this format is supported under UBL 3.0 for Peppoland this solution will introduce which has an identical subset as XRechnung

Solution

- Project driven integration in CIG
- Messages in scope
 - Receive XRechnung BIS 3.0 UBL Invoices from Suppliers
 - CIG Translate from XRechnung BIS 3.0 UBL to cXML InvoiceDetailRequest
