




Introducing: Performing Supplier Management Tasks Using the SAP Ariba Procurement Mobile App

Search and View Suppliers

Search for suppliers: Users can search for suppliers by name, contact details, or location from the **Supplier Management** page, and view detailed information about them.

View supplier 360° profile: Users can tap a supplier's name to see their 360° profile. The supplier 360° profile shows all of the information your organization has about a supplier.

Note: Only the **Summary** and the **Registration** sections are displayed in the mobile app.





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Request new suppliers: Users who want to request to work with new suppliers, create and submit internal supplier request forms. When a supplier request is approved, the supplier is created in your site.


View supplier registrations: Users can view a list of the available supplier registrations in various statuses.



Introducing: Support for Copying Requisitions and Line Items in the SAP Ariba Procurement Mobile App

Copying Requisitions

- Users can use the **Buy again** menu option to make a copy of an existing requisition.
- Users can then modify requisition details, add or delete items, and submit it for approval.
- Requisitions can be copied regardless of their state



Feature at a Glance Introducing: Enhanced Warnings for Force Order and Force Cancel

Detailed feature information - Force Order

This feature enhances the warnings that are displayed when users perform the force order or the force cancel action. This way users are better informed about following actions they might need to take.

 In the respective Purchase Order, that is still in Ordering state, users can click on the Force Order button.

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


Introducing: Give select users permission to modify attachments in approved requisitions

Detailed feature information

When adding or removing attachments as a user with **Managed Approved Requisition Attachments**, users will now be prompted with a warning message letting them know that any change to attachments is permanent.

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Feature at a Glance Introducing: Self-service transfer of ownership

Detailed feature information

Transferring ownership can be performed by opening the transfer of ownership form and filling in the relevant details.

- From User refers to the user who the approvable documents currently belong to
- **To User** refers to the user who will receive ownership of the approvable documents
- Approvable Type refers to which type of approvable documents will be transferred. Options for this field are Purchase Requisition, Invoice and All. Note that Transferring ownership of purchase requisitions will cascade transfer of ownership of purchase orders and receipts associated with the purchase requisition. Transferring ownership of invoices will also transfer ownership of invoice reconciliations associated with the invoice.
- **Approvable Status** refers to the status that the approvable documents to be transferred are in
- **Date Range** refers to the range of creation dates for which approvable documents will be transferred
- Reason provides context for others including approvers for why the transfer is being performed
- · Additional comments can be added for additional context
- Clicking the **Apply** button uses the above criteria to search for documents requiring transfer

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
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Introducing: Support for supplier diversity information in non-catalog purchase

Detailed feature information


Diversity labels appear on recommended suppliers when viewing suppliers in a supplier carousel or when selecting suppliers in a non-catalog requisition.



Introducing: Support for supplier diversity information in non-catalog purchase

Detailed feature information

Recommended suppliers can now also be filtered by their diversity indicators. The supplier diversity program can also be highlighted in the details of the supplier. When selecting a diverse supplier, users will be thanked for promoting diversity.
