



IG-30121 Support for the United Arab Emirates data center in SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway

Customer Challenge

Currently, CIG has 4 data centers based in Europe, US, China (CN), Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA). Europe data center is the CIG default data center for all customers outside of US regions, CN and KSA. CIG customers based in the United Arab Emirates (UAE) are required to use the Europe data center since CIG does not have stand-alone data center and this conflicts with data residency requirement wherein sensitive data cannot leave the country's boundaries.

Solution

- CIG deployment at UAE Data Center
- Provision to connect SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway account to the United Arab Emirates data center for hosting the business data of Ariba Network and SAP Ariba solutions.

Key Benefits

 With this feature, customer's sensitive business data remains within country's boundaries, meeting data residency requirement from their cybersecurity laws.

Technical Overview

As a new buyer or a supplier, you can consider the following points:

- Choose UAE data center in the drop-down list and send the data synchronization request from SAP Ariba applications to SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway data center.
- Point single sign-on (SSO) from SAP Ariba applications to SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway data center chosen from the drop-down list



Customer Challenge

 With the existing Test Central buyer regression functionality, buyers have a provision to create test suites which don't require any manual intervention, where the test cases would be sequentially executed based on follow on documents. But when the customer has a scenario where manual step is required to proceed in the execution, they do not have an option with the current solution.

Solution

 This feature enhances the buyer regression functionality in the Test Central framework to include manual steps in test cases while creating and running test suites.

Key Benefits

- Customers can now add manual steps as a Testcase while creating or rerunning an existing test suite. They can
 perform manual steps outside of the test central application. Test Central holds the step until the buyer
 completes the manual activity.
- This enables buyers to perform a manual activity outside Test Central, which is an essential part of running a test case.

Customer Challenge

- Currently, the inventory reservation document that is sent from SAP Ariba Buying to SAP ERP or SAP S/4HANA using SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway doesn't contain enough information such as (requester, recipient, recipient plant) to retrieve the reservation from stock and send it to the requester.
- This restricts the delivery of goods to the requester.

Solution

- This feature enables buyers to include below additional information while creating the inventory reservation document that is sent from SAP Ariba Buying to SAP ERP or SAP S/4HANA using SAP Ariba Cloud Integration Gateway:
 - Created by user name
 - Unloading Point
 - Goods Recipient/ Ship to Party
 - Item Text

Key Benefits

 With this feature, buyers will be able to add the additional details in the reservation document to retrieve the reservation from the stock and send it to requester.
