# Introducing: Order Change Request APIs

### **Customer Challenge**

Currently it is not possible for buyers and direct suppliers to connect to AN via B2B and retrieve the change request relevant information or for the suppliers to post change request response.

This would enable direct suppliers to connect to AN via B2B.

### **Experience Key Benefits**

This would enable direct suppliers to connect to AN via B2B and provide an additional option for the buyers to connect to AN via B2B.

## **Prerequisites, Restrictions**



### **Prerequisites**

- To create an application and request access to use the SAP Ariba APIs relevant to this feature, you must have access to the SAP Ariba developer portal.
- SAP Ariba Supply Chain Collaboration entitlement needs to be enabled to use the capability.
- All queries made to this API must be authenticated using OAuth authentication.
- For buyers You must configure the API client ID in Ariba Network for buyers.

#### Restrictions

- Use of SAP Ariba APIs for suppliers using the SAP Ariba developer portal is restricted to Ariba Network suppliers with Enterprise accounts.
  Access to the SAP Ariba developer portal is restricted for all other Ariba Network supplier account types. For example, Standard Account suppliers cannot access the SAP Ariba developer portal.
- The APIs for buyers can retrieve data only for suppliers in a relationship with you.
- The APIs for suppliers can retrieve and send data only for buyers in a relationship with you.
- These APIs do not support retrieving or sending data from change requests for scheduling agreements or scheduling agreement releases.

# **User Story**




The buyers and suppliers are collaborating using purchase orders. With changing customer demand, material planner(buyer) has to react on hundreds of needed changes for existing purchase orders daily. The planner/buyer has to share the purchase order change proposals (only quantity and date changes) as order change request with the supplier based on the results of buyers MRP or other planning runs and allow supplier to provide feedback before receiving changes for purchase orders.

Supplier responds back to the order change request sent by buyer by


- Accepting the changes proposed to the PO.
- Rejecting the changes proposed to the PO.
- Providing alternate proposal based on the changes proposed to the PO.

# **Feature Details Open APIs for Buyers**



The Order Change Requests API for Buyers enables buyers to request relevant information from Ariba Network for purchase-order change requests.

This API uses the following endpoints:

GET /changeRequests

This endpoint retrieves information from change requests sent to a specified supplier.

GET /changeRequestResponses

This endpoint retrieves information from responses to change requests that were sent by a specified supplier.

GET /changeRequestConfirmations

This endpoint retrieves information from confirmations to change requests that were sent by a specified buyer.

# **Feature Details Open APIs for Suppliers**



The Order Change Requests API for Suppliers enables you to request relevant information from Ariba Network and post change request responses for purchase-order change requests.

This API includes the following endpoints:

GET /changeRequests

The /changeRequests endpoint retrieves information from change requests sent by a specified buyer.

GET /changeRequestResponses

 The /changeRequestResponses endpoint retrieves information from responses to change requests that were sent to a specified buyer.

GET /changeRequestConfirmations

 The /changeRequestConfirmations endpoint retrieves information from confirmations to change requests that were sent to a specified supplier.

POST /changeRequestResponses

 The /changeRequestResponses endpoint sends information from responses to change requests that were sent to a specified buyer.
