Introducing: Self-service transfer of ownership

Customer challenge

Employees within an organization often change responsibilities or require another party to manage transactions on their behalf, requiring purchasing and invoicing documents transferred to alternate team members.

Prior to this feature, these scenarios would require intervention from an administrator or other party to perform the document reassignment on the user's behalf. This creates additional effort for users and administrators for requesting changes and responding to these changes with no approval process within the solution and document transfer auditability.

Solution area

SAP Ariba Buying with guided buying capability SAP Ariba Buying and Invoicing with guided buying capability

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

This feature introduces a self-service method to transfer the ownership of approvable documents, like purchase requisitions (PR) and the corresponding follow-on documents, from one user to another leveraging APIs within guided buying to facilitate transfer.

It allows any user in an organization to submit a transfer request, with the required changes, for the selected approvable documents. The submitted request is directed through a predefined approval flow. Ownership of the document will be transferred to the new owner when the request is approved by all the approvers automatically.

Implementation information

This feature is automatically on for all customers with the applicable solutions but requires **customer configuration**.

Experience key benefits

- Guided buying users will now have the ability to manage their own document transfer with customer configured approval processes.
- Administrators will no longer need to intervene in all requests to transfer ownership of transactional documents. They will, however, have the ability to audit the process as required.
- A global form template is available to configure the capability, reducing the time to implement this feature while still offering customer specific process configuration.

Prerequisites and Restrictions

- This feature requires the guided buying capability.
- Enable the SAP Ariba Buying parameter: Application.TransferOwnershipRequest.Enabled.
- This parameter is self-service. You can enable using the Intelligent Configuration Manager interface.
- Enable the guided buying parameter:
 PARAM_ENABLE_TRANSFER_OF_OWNERSHIP

Introducing: Self-service transfer of ownership


Detailed feature information

Transferring ownership can be performed by opening the transfer of ownership form and completing the required fields.

- From User refers to the user who the approvable documents currently belong
- To User refers to the user who will receive ownership of the approvable documents
- Approvable Type refers to which type of approvable documents will be transferred.
 Options for this field are Purchase Requisition, Invoice and All.
- Approvable Status refers to the status that the approvable documents to be transferred are in.
- Date Range refers to the range of creation dates for which approvable documents will be transferred
- Reason provides context for approvers for why the transfer is being performed
- Additional comments can be added for additional context
- Clicking the Apply button uses the above criteria to search for documents requiring transfer

Note that transferring ownership of purchase requisitions will cascade transfer of ownership of purchase orders and receipts associated with the purchase requisition.

Transferring ownership of invoices will also transfer ownership of invoice reconciliations associated with the invoice.



Introducing: Self-service transfer of ownership


Document selection and approvals

Once the API has retrieved documents that meet the search criteria, the user can select the desired approvable documents to be included in the transfer.

Upon clicking **Submit** the transfer of ownership will proceed through the approval flow configured in the form.

Once approvers have approved, the transfer of ownership will be processed automatically and documents will be transferred to their new owner.

The transfer can be exported to reflect the same in your ERP solution, utilizing a webservice integration.

Introducing: Support for personal ship-to addresses

Customer challenge

Where personal addresses or "ad-hoc" ship-to addresses have been used in the past, there has been no ability to validate that the address is correct.

This has resulted in incorrect delivery information and presents a risk for any tax validation based on address information.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

Users can now create and manage their own ship-to addresses outside of the requisition flow, which is useful if they're working from home, a client's office, or a temporary residence. They can select these addresses when they order, and suppliers will ship directly to them.

When an address is entered, guided buying validates it to ensure it's correct, and displays a standardized address that users can select.

Users can configure personal addresses so that only shippers, service providers, and guided buying administrators see them, as "private" addresses.

Experience key benefits

- Reduce purchase order delivery issues and additional workload for administrators and suppliers.
- Reduce tax compliance workload where addresses are invalid.
- Reduce integration errors between procurement solutions and backend systems.





Manage your addresses directly from your user profile in guided buying.




- Typeahead validates the address as you type (available for selected countries).
- · Address can also be directly entered.




Introducing: Support for personal ship-to addresses

 Click to hide the address from other guided buying users; they see only the words "Private Address." Only shippers, service providers, and guided buying administrators can see the address.



Addresses are stored for use in Requisitions and Non-PO invoices (optional).

Customer challenge

To deliver the best possible user experience, casual users require a simple and effective way to search catalog, spot buy, procurement forms, suppliers and other content in guided guying.

Meet that challenge with

SAP Ariba

Guided buying search results have been redesigned to enhance the user experience when accessing different types of content.

The search typeahead now displays recent search information with the relevant buying channel to help users refine their search dynamically. When search results are displayed, the user is presented with links to different buying channels to help segregate content. Catalog content is now displayed with pagination and items in search results contain more information about the item to aid faster content selection and easy comparison.

This feature is optional for this release. With the Q1 2302 release, SAP Ariba plans to turn it on for all customers.

Experience key benefits

- Search bar typeahead based on a user's search history helps users refine and access frequently searched content faster.
- Tagging of preferred items and visibility of lead time in search results minimizes required clicks to find the right item.
- Filtering options such as inventory, preferred items and supplier diversity drive visibility and prominence of these items.
- Pagination of catalog search results improves navigation.




Search bar now displays shopping history:

When you search for an item tabs for each buy channel containing the item will be displayed at the top of the results page:




More information about the search result is now displayed such as preferred/qualified status, shipping status, corporate social responsibility indicators or hazardous material indicator:




