- SAP Ariba Shopping is available on Android 8.0 and above.



- Administrators can successfully guide users to preferred products via catalog kits.












Support for punching in to guided buying from work orders in the 4R2 integration scenario

Customer challenge

- Maintenance planners need a simple and user-friendly means to add materials and services to their work orders.
- They also need the ability to source an accurate quote for services or materials when a request is complex or details are unknown but quotes should be based on the pricing in the contract. Examples include hourly rates of an expert service technician or the need to detail the project scope before a precise quote can be offered.

Description

Work orders are used to procure maintenance and repair services for plants and machinery. This feature enables maintenance planners to punch in to guided buying from a work order in the Plant Maintenance module in SAP S/4HANA to add items required for their order.

Customer benefit

This feature provides maintenance planners with an enhanced user experience by:

- Utilizing the guided buying catalog search for selecting items to add to the shopping cart
- Enabling them to create a request for estimate and return the resulting quote to their work order



Improved search in guided buying

Customer challenge

When casual users search for an item in guided buying, comparing items and filtering for green, inventory or hazardous items should be simple and easy to achieve.

Description

The search results page was recently redesigned by adding tabs for buying channels and other features to help improve searching. Now additional changes have been made to further improve the search experience:

- You can now filter inventory items, hazardous materials, and preferred items in the search results.
- Inventory items are now tagged accordingly and displayed for easy identification.
- The comparison display has been enhanced by icons indicating green, hazardous, and preferred items.

Customer benefit

- This feature further evolves the search experience in guided buying for the casual user and improves the visibility of green, hazardous and preferred items.
- The updated display of inventory items further extends the inventory reservation capability for customers who use guided buying for this process.



- Icons show green, hazardous, and preferred items.
- You can filter for inventory items (Is Stocked section), preferred items, and hazardous materials.
- Items details include the plant and storage location.


