Import risk assessment response for an engagement request

Description

- This feature allows you to map SAP Business Network as the data source for responses to a modular questionnaire used as an assessment in engagement requests.

Customer benefit

- Improve compliance and consistency by mapping an SAP standard assessment to a modular questionnaire used as an assessment for engagement requests. This allows you to import responses so that suppliers only have to respond to the assessment in one place.

Prerequisites, restrictions, cautions

Prerequisites

Your site must be configured for use of control-based engagement risk assessment projects.

Suppliers for which you intend to import assessment responses must be registered SAP Business Network suppliers, and there must be an established trading relationship between the supplier and your organization in SAP Business Network.

Restrictions

The `CreateModularQuestionnairesFromStandardAssessments` scheduled task creates a modular questionnaire template named **Human Rights**, mapped to the SAP Business Network standard assessment of the same name. It does not currently have the ability to create modular questionnaire templates for any other SAP standard assessments.

Cautions

To ensure correct behavior and consistency with the standard assessment from which this modular questionnaire was created, only change the template settings per the documentation. Do not modify the questions, their mappings, or any other attributes.

Feature details

Feature Overview

- The **Human Rights** modular questionnaire template is mapped to an assessment of the same name on SAP Business Network, and specific questions on the two sides are mapped to each other.
- With this feature enabled, you can set up a modular questionnaire template to have responses for an engagement risk assessment imported from SAP Business Network.
- Once setup is complete, the send assessments task does not send the assessments configured to import responses to the supplier; instead, responses for those assessments are imported.
- The response import can happen only when the SAP Business Network registered supplier has responded to the assessment on the SAP Business Network side, and has approved sharing that response.

- Enable self-service configuration parameters.
 - Application.SR.Engagement.RiskAssessmentDataImport**
 - Import risk assessment data for engagement requests
 - Application.SR.Engagement.ImportResponsesFromBusinessNetwork**
 - Ability to select SAP business network as the data source for assessment responses
- As a member of the Customer Administrator group, run the **CreateModularQuestionnairesFromStandardAssessments** scheduled task which automates the creation of a modular questionnaire named **Human Rights**.
 - The resulting questionnaire contains identical questions with appropriate mappings to the SAP Business Network Supplier Assessment Questionnaire.

As a Template Creator, navigate to the **Manage > Templates > Modular Questionnaires Mapped to SAP Standard Assessments** folder and find the newly created **Human Rights** modular questionnaire.

- You must manually adjust several settings for the new template so that you can import responses for it.
