This feature gives an overview of the supplier's sourcing events in the Sourcing Events panel and the contract workspaces in the Contracts panel in the Summary area in the supplier 360° profile. The new Business activity area in the supplier 360° profile lists the supplier's sourcing events and contracts.

 With this feature, the buyers get an overview of the supplier's activities across SAP Ariba applications in one place in the supplier 360° profile. You can get insight into the supplier's activities without switching between SAP Ariba applications.

# Prerequisites, restrictions, cautions

## **Prerequisites**

For SAP Ariba Supplier Information and Performance Management, this feature requires the "new architecture."

You must enable the following parameters in **SM Administration** -> **Configuration Parameters**:

- Application.SM.UI.SourcingSummary: Enabling this parameter shows the Sourcing Events panel in the Summary area and the Business activity area in the supplier 360° profile.
- Application.SM.UI.ContractsSummary: Enabling this parameter shows the Contracts panel in the Summary area and the Business activity area in the supplier 360° profile.

You must be a member of the **SM Ops Administrator** group to set these parameters.


## Restrictions

# **Feature details**

- In the Summary area in the supplier 360° profile, new Sourcing Events and Contracts panels are introduced that give an overview of the supplier's activities in the sourcing and contracts applications.
- Clicking the sourcing and contracts statuses takes you to the new **Business activity** area in the supplier 360° profile, which lists the supplier's sourcing events and contracts.
- The new Business activity area lists the supplier's activities in other SAP Ariba applications.
  - You can choose a business activity from the dropdown to view a list of the supplier's sourcing events or contracts.
  - You can filter the business activity based on their statuses. For specific sourcing events or contracts, you can also browse using the search bar.
  - Clicking the sourcing event or contract name takes you to the respective application and gives detailed information about the supplier's activities.
