


Traditionally, Buyers collect data for processes like qualification and risk due diligence in a one to one exchange with Suppliers. As a Supplier, these requests are similar from most or all of their Buyers and the process is redundant and inefficient.

With the Supplier Self-Assessment Questionnaire, Suppliers can prepare for Human Rights due diligence requests from their Buyers.

As a Supplier, you can proactively complete the questionnaire and share on SAP Business Network – a Buyer request is not needed to access or complete. You can select Buyers with whom you wish to share the assessment. You can complete the assessment once and share with many Buyers. Any updates you make are automatically sent via notification to Buyers with whom you've shared the assessment.

As a Buyer, you can send a request from SAP Business Network or from SAP Ariba Risk. You can then review the completed assessment from either channel.




SAP Business Network

Completing a Self-Assessment Questionnaire

Buyer Requested

- 1. Buyer makes request
- Supplier receives an email & in-app notification for each Buyer request
- Supplier completes assessment and selects Buyers with whom to share


Supplier Initiated

1. Supplier can access under the 'Assessments' tab and complete


 Supplier can share with selected Buyers as requested – the assessment can be completed once and shared with many Buyers

Sharing a Self-Assessment Questionnaire


- Suppliers can share with one or more Buyers
- Once shared, all assessment updates are sent to Buyers automatically and Suppliers can add comments for Buyers on updates
- Buyers receive a notification on email and in-app any time an update is available
